At the moment, two phases of the project are complete, we still have 30% of work to be done on the third phase, the Water Tower to make 100% functional. Most of this has been realized by funds from Global Giving and direct funding.

The project objective to provide access to clean safe drinking water, has been realized on campus, and to about 40% of the local community. A section that is still wanting is to complete plumbing work, and be able to reach more people in the community. As we work towards helping our students discover their purpose and be able to make a difference in the society, we also wish to empower more members of this community with similar ideals.
