EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

High-level overview	Fed more 6000+ urban poor who reside in 50 Villages of Kampala and Wakiso and depend on hand to mouth, providing them with crucial food to sustain them during this time when their source of income is no longer available.
Project purpose and duration/timeline	To feed urban poor families affected by corona virus pandemic. These are daily income earners and do not have savings nor food to sustain them in this lockdown and immediately after since it will take them a bit of time to return to their normal way earning. This project was immediate due to the urgency of the matter.
Outside organisations or NGOs involved in delivery	We involved local authorities at distribution level including LCs, RDCs and Police, Office of The Prime Minister, Office of the President.
Key deliverables/benefits	We provided maize super maize flour and good quality beans to more than 6000 families; attached is proof of the beneficiaries with their names, contacts and addresses.

Background

Since the outbreak of Corona Virus Pandemic, third world countries with families surviving on less than a dollar per day have been heavily affected.

In the urban centers such as in Kampala and Wakiso, the poor population that survives from hand to mouth is estimated at 3 million people. These do not have food stored nor savings to sustain them during this lock down and whereas government tried to reach out to them, it has been proven that it did not even cover half of the targeted population according to the local media as well as the survey

made by Heal The Planet Global Organisation through focused group discussions carried out in these given areas namely Kawempe, Nsambya, Katwe, and Makerere kivulu (in Kampala), Makindye, Masajja, (in Wakiso).

On 25th May Heal The Planet Global Organisation- HTP guided by our Legal Team we signed Prudential Assurance Uganda Contract (SLA) of UGX 150,000,000/= slightly equivalent to U\$40,000 to enable us execute this under taking. This was part of UGX 300,000,000 million (\$ 80,000) towards food relief in the country.

The donation purpose was to feed the most vulnerable and poor who have been greatly affected by the lockdown, many of whom live on less than a dollar a day and therefore do not have any savings to help them go through this period. This is was distributed via two organisations: Humanitarian Operations Projects and Emergencies (HOPE) and Heal the Planet Global Organisation (HTP).

The world is facing a major calamity in the history of our life time. The Corona Virus Pandemic has paralysed all activities affecting Governments, Organisations and People's daily lifestyle. Nobody has ever believed that there would be a situation that will leave 7 Billion people on earth indoor and others quarantined.

Since the outbreak of Corona Virus Pandemic, third world countries with families surviving on less than a dollar per day have been heavily affected.

These do not have food stored nor savings to sustain them during this lock down and whereas government is trying to reach out to them, it has been proven that it has not even covered half of the targeted population according to the local media

as well as the survey made by Heal The Planet Global Organisation through focused group discussions carried out.

We're grateful that Prudential Insurance Company has thought about these urban poor people and given back to the community amidst harsh economic crisis the world has gotten into.

We had earlier reached out to several entities to support this campaign as we have always gotten financial support from companies, individuals, governments and organization whenever we reach out to them to support our causes and campaigns.

The donation of UGX 150m Prudential has decided to avail to us will contribute to food aid for some families estimated at 6000 in areas namely Nsambya, Katwe, Bwaise and Makerere kivulu (in Kampala), Makindye, Masajja, (in Wakiso).

We're going to feed urban poor families affected by corona virus pandemic. These are daily income earners and do not have enough savings nor food to sustain them in this lockdown and immediately after since it will take them a bit of time to return to their normal way earning.

This project is immediate due to the urgency of the matter and will span for a period of two months.

We aim at providing posho and beans to 6000 individuals to sustain them for atleast 20 days.

As an NGO, we are permitted to conduct any humanitarian activities but we are going to involve local authorities at distribution level including LCs, RDCs and Police as mandated by the law during this time.

HTP will ensure transparence, equality, efficiency and good will in executing this project at all levels.

Heal The Planet Global Organisation holds Special Consultative Status with United Nations since 2017 though we started in 2011.

We Submitted an Invoice to prudential for COVID 19- 2020 Donation on **26th May 2020**

Day 2- Held Meeting with Senior officials at Office of the Prime Minister and agreed to distribute food direct to beneficiaries in the areas stipulated in our agreement.

For purposes of recording the Donation in the National Tusk force Books we also planned to present some of the food donations before Prime Minister and then we kick off the distribution while working with local authorities as advised by Prudential Chairman during the Press Conference.

Day 3- Wed 27th May Were in the field engaging local leaders.



Thursday 28th May Continued to engage local leaders

Friday 29th May - We started on the bidding process and advert was to run early the following week in Local newspaper. We also continued to meet local leaders.

Wed 10th we conducted meeting with Resident District Commissioner - RDC (office of the president) in Makindye. He welcomed the news of the Project and on Sunday he agreed to a meeting with all LC leaders in his jurisdiction of Makindye, Katwe & Nsambya Parishes which President Kivumbi addressed.





Thursday 11 we had a separate meeting of 10 LC leaders of Katwe all together they are compiling list of beneficiaries in their areas and just waiting for our distribution.

Another meeting was held the same day with RDC of Kawempe who wasn't around when first meeting with GISO & DISO of the area was conducted.



RDC on strong appeal requested that we distribute the food to Komamboga not Bwaise (Both in Kawempe) since Komamboga has never received any food yet government distribution ended.

Fri 12, Sat 13 Daily Updates.

HTP appreciated Prudential Team for coming a day before and communicated on Prime Minister's planned wave off on Monday. More engagements were made with Deputy RCC in Kasangati who covers Wakiso. Another meeting was held with Police DPC Wandendeya & DPC CPS will promise of another meeting with with Kampala Metropolitan after PM meeting.

Sat 13th Continued to supervise beans packaging and maize as well a printing Branded bags.

Tue 16 - Kicked off food distribution in Komamboga assisted with LC leaders and more than five villages received food, Prudential Team of about 12 people was with us.

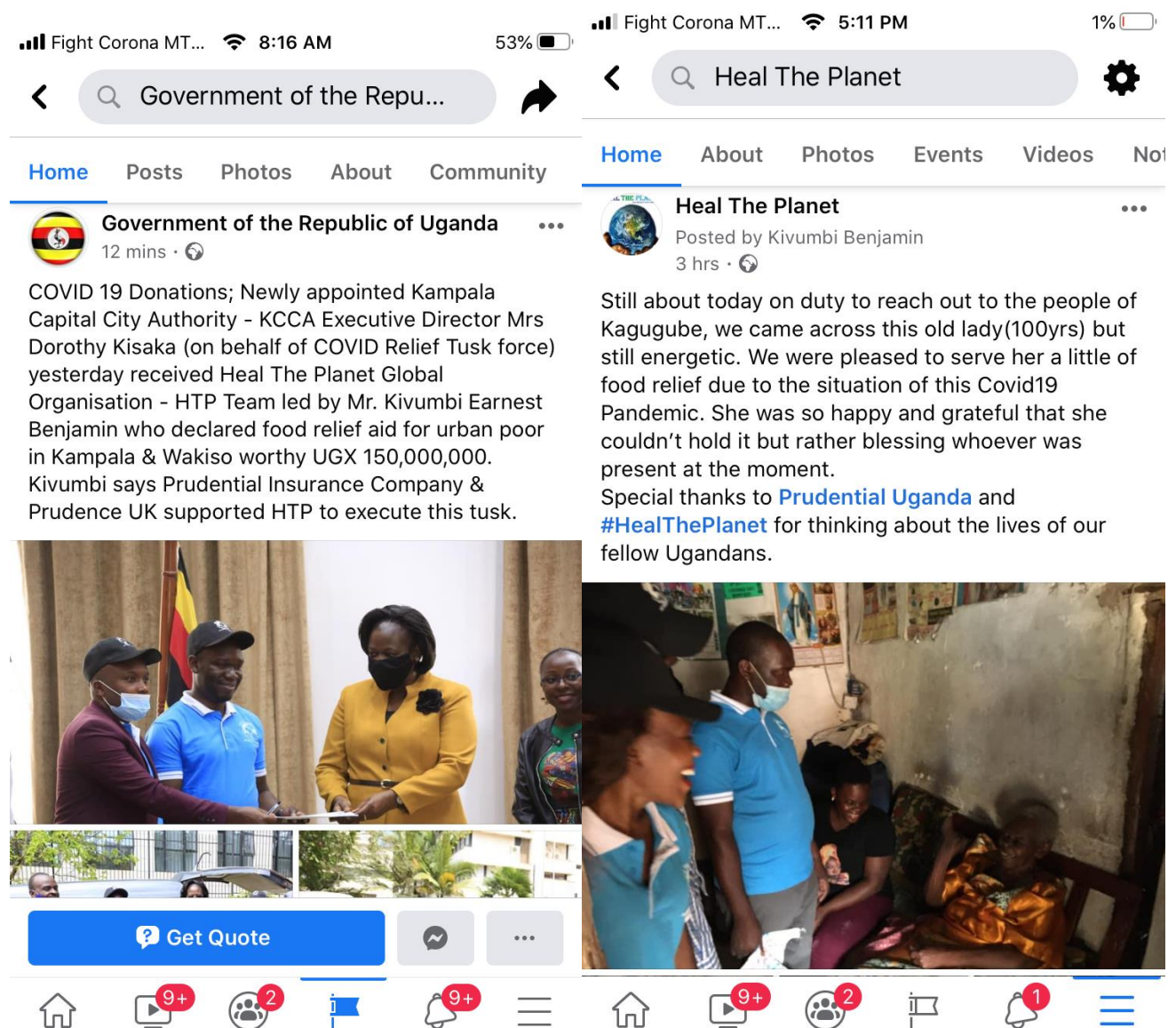


Wed 17 Covered Kampala Central , 5 villages received food including Kagugube, Kitamanyangamba, Makerere Kivulu 2, Kivulu 1 & Industrial area. We were overwhelmed by the disturbing vicious poverty and needs of these slum

dwellers. A rum chuckled house in 1 room housing 9 people. HTP President was personally touched by an old woman 100 years who is in 2 room house with 10 family members. Prudential team of 12 also joined us. We first had security meeting with DPC Wandegeya, LCs and another with DISO at KCCA office.

On the consideration of Prudential the leaders and security operative in places we reached asked part of the food meant for between 50-70 people.

Also our team expressed concern about beneficiaries signing with our pens as that can trigger COVID fears though we strongly availed them protective gears and sanitizers. We therefore requested that instead of signing are details be captured including NINs and phone.


