ECUADOR MARCH 2023



In March 2023, the team of expert volunteers from Global Smile Foundation (GSF) spent 2 weeks in Guayaquil, Ecuador for the first of two outreach cleft programs in the country this year. GSF's programs take place at Hospital León Becerra, a nonprofit children's hospital in Guayaquil that serves a low-income population.


At the beginning of this program, our team evaluated more than 270 patients for surgical readiness. Ultimately, our team performed 192 surgical procedures for 70 patients, Some patients who did not undergo surgery this time are scheduled to receive care during on the next trip in September 2023.

GSF provides **integrated** and **long-term** cleft care. Our volunteer teams include professionals from the range of cleft care specialties, such as surgery, anesthesiology, nursing, pediatrics, speech pathology, dentistry, orthodontics, and psychology.

The March team included 60 international cleft and pediatric specialists, as well as 64 Ecuadorian healthcare providers and volunteers from GSF's in-country organization, Fundación Global Smile-Ecuador.

GSF also provides education and training for in-country providers during outreach programs to build sustainable capacity for cleft care in Ecuador. In March, our team members lead sessions on **Sedation and General Anesthesia in Pediatric Dentistry** and **NasoAlveolar Molding (NAM)**.

OVIDIO'S STORY

In 2018, the GSF team met **Ovidio** (above). Like many infants with cleft, he was underweight. Cleft lip or palate can prevent an infant from feeding properly, increasing the risk of malnourishment. Donations from GSF supporters provide special bottles and enriched formula so that GSF patients can grow and thrive.

After six months, Ovidio returned for cleft lip surgery and, a year later, he came back for cleft palate surgery. Our team sees Ovidio and his family every year for evaluation and dental care. He graduated from Kindergarten this spring and we expect to begin speech therapy soon.
