Our Impact



GOOD HEALTH AND WELLBEING

45,000 young people have participated in VAP's health programs. Participants are 71% more likely to know their status than their peers and their HIV knowledge increases by 20% on average.



QUALITY EDUCATION

VAP's youth-led education programs support young people in STEM learning and mobile libraries. Participants develop critical thinking, creative problem-solving, and leadership skills.




GENDER EQUALITY

VAP has single-sex programs for girls and boys that focus on building gender-equitable norms, question societally-imposed gender roles, and encourage women to participate in sport.



EMPLOYABILITY AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

400 young people have graduated from E+E program of which 92% were women and 76% are employed or have a job in the pipeline.




Empower the Future 2020-2025


The Center will include:


- An office block
