Land acquisition is the critical first step for one of the most restorable tidal marshlands on California's North Coast, along the Salt River in the Eel River Delta.



Our recent purchase fronts critical habitat along the North Channel of the Alsea River and Drift Creek, conserving critical habitat for Oregon Coastal coho salmon.
