Sunbula, established in 1996 in Jerusalem, is a fair trade organization that empowers Palestinian artisans especially those most marginalized - by promoting their traditional handicrafts. Sunbula partners with 25 different local groups, empowering a total of 2,000 artisans, in the West Bank including East Jerusalem, the Gaza Strip, and Palestinian communities inside Israel. Women, refugees, people with disabilities, small-scale farmers and members of minority groups benefit from income that is generated at Sunbula fair trade stores, product development training by professional designers, and other types of sustaining support. At the same time, Sunbula works to preserve and revitalize the cultural heritage of Palestine.






