

OUR HIST ORY

Fundación San Genaro was born in 2011, to carry out social projects that aim to improve the quality of life of people in vulnerable situations in Argentina.

The first project we developed was "Cultivando Escuelas", with the initial objective of helping rural schools located in deprived areas, providing them with basic donations.

After knowing the reality of the rural schools of Santiago del Estero, we decided to frame the project in a program with medium and long-term objectives, implementing a variety of workshops and activities with a focus on the education and health of the children.

Throughout that first experience, we discovered the importance of working together with local institutions that are

referents in the communities in which we sought to influence.

Furthermore, we understood the leading role not only of children but also of women, as agents of intrinsic change in each community.

For this reason, we reconfigure our mission, prioritizing the strengthening of grassroots social institutions (schools, canteens, clubs, and social centers), through programs focused on education and health for children, and women's development.

Thus, we are working today to create new alliances with other relevant actors (state entities, NGOs, and companies), seeking to achieve –among all- a real contribution in improving the quality of life of vulnerable communities.

MISSION. Work together with grassroots organizations to improve the quality of life of underprivileged communities. We seek to strengthen schools, social institutions and community kitchens, through programs focused on education and health for children, and empowerment of women.



VISION. We believe in the leadership of a community strengthened by its local organizations, that generates its own tools to be a change agent.



OUR PROGRAMS

RURAL EDUCATION SUPPORT

We aim to revitalize rural schools located in the south of Santiago del Estero (Argentina). We provide equipment for schools and students supplies, and we offer different activities focused on three areas:







NUTRITION: students walk at least 5 miles every day to get to school. At the same time, the school cafeteria does not have the necessary resources to ensure a daily lunch for children. For this reason, we seek to guarantee student's food security through the donation of highly nutritious meals. Additionally, we carry out nutritional monitoring of the children and offer open talks to the rural community.








LITERATURE: Intending to improve educational quality, we offer literature workshops to students, emphasizing the literary foray through reading and interpreting texts. In addition, we donate libraries full of children's literacy, and we offer training workshops for school teachers.





HEALTH: a group of volunteer doctors visits schools twice a year to provide primary health care for children and young people from 0 to 18 years old. In addition, we work to ensure access to clean water providing water purifiers to rural families and schools

We work together with grassroots organizations (such as community kitchens and social institutions) located in underprivileged areas of Buenos Aires, assisting them with basic needs and offering institutional support







WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

We know that women have a leading role as promoters of the spirit of change. For this reason, we offer workshops and activities focused on their development and empowerment, in our headquarters and allied grassroots social organizations
