

EDUCATION FOR ALL : Empowering Girls Through Education



Every Child Has A Right To Learn

Girls' education is not just about getting girls into school.

It is about ensuring that girls feel safe and supported while in school so they can complete all levels of education. It's also about girls acquiring the knowledge and skills needed to compete in the labour market and building the life skills necessary to make informed decisions about their own lives and contribute to their families, communities and the world.

When you compound the challenges they face with the impacts of COVID-19, including increasing levels of gender-based violence, child marriages, early pregnancies, harmful traditional practices and other obstacles to girls' access to education, the world quickly becomes a difficult place for young girls to navigate – but it's not without hope. And education is the answer.

Project Overview: How You Will Help

- Construct a twelve-classroom girl's-only secondary school, including classrooms, two science labs, library and admin buildings.
- Provide textbooks, chalkboards, desks and chairs, lab equipment and supplies and library books.
- Drill one borehole well, a solar pump and water storage.
- Install latrines, handwashing facilities and garbage disposals on school grounds.
- Provide dedicated, professional psychosocial counsellors at the school to promote positive coping and resilience.
- We aim to open the school in January 2022.



Project At A Glance

Project Location: Mai Mahiu, Nakuru County, Kenya

Timeline: School opening January 2022

Who You Will Help: 600 vulnerable girls from the community where the school is located.

Impact: Girls will have, for the first time, the opportunity to attend high school. Drop out rates are currently high as there is no high school within the community. This affects all children, but girls in particular face increased risk of violence and exploitation as they walk long distances alone to schools outside their communities.

About Village Impact

Village Impact is a grassroots, registered Canadian charity that provides access to community-led education, leadership, and economic opportunities for thousands of children in rural Kenya's internally displaced peoples' communities.

Since 2009, we've constructed and resourced 14 public schools (primary and secondary) that have provided sustainable solutions for communities to access quality education.

Our projects currently focus on communities recovering from conflict in Nakuru County, about 97 miles (165 km) northwest of Nairobi in Kenya.

In partnership with children, parents, local leaders, NGO partners, local government and donors, we help vulnerable communities in Kenya build and resource schools, facilitate professional development for teachers and administrators, and deliver extension learning and business training opportunities for children and youth.

During COVID, we've also turned our attention to initiatives that help keep children healthy and fit for learning.
