\$2.5M Disbursed on Housing | Enterprise | Agriculture | Live Stock

Overview

In 2022, torrential monsoon rains triggered the most severe flooding that the country had ever witnessed, washing away villages and leaving millions of people in need of immediate support, hundreds of thousands of homes were damaged or destroyed, leaving over 2 million people without adequate shelter. There was a substantial loss of crops, livestock, and human life due to water-borne diseases & malnutrition.



Akhuwat, in line with its philosophy of 'Brotherhood' set out to provide relief support to flood affectees across the country. The organization's initial response primarily focused on providing humanitarian assistance to the victims and meeting immediate needs such as food, shelter, clothing, and medical assistance. (The immediate target is facilitating 75,000 families.)

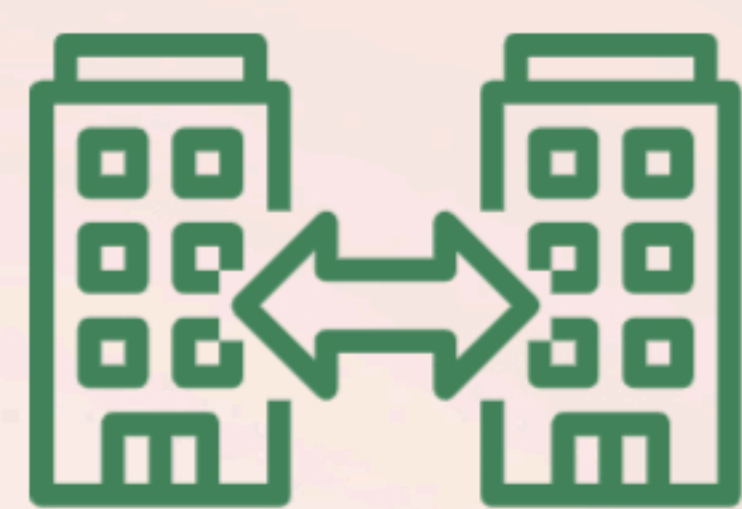
44,000 + Families are supported with cash

2,186 Volunteers helping us raise funds, spread awareness and doing amazing job to help flood victims

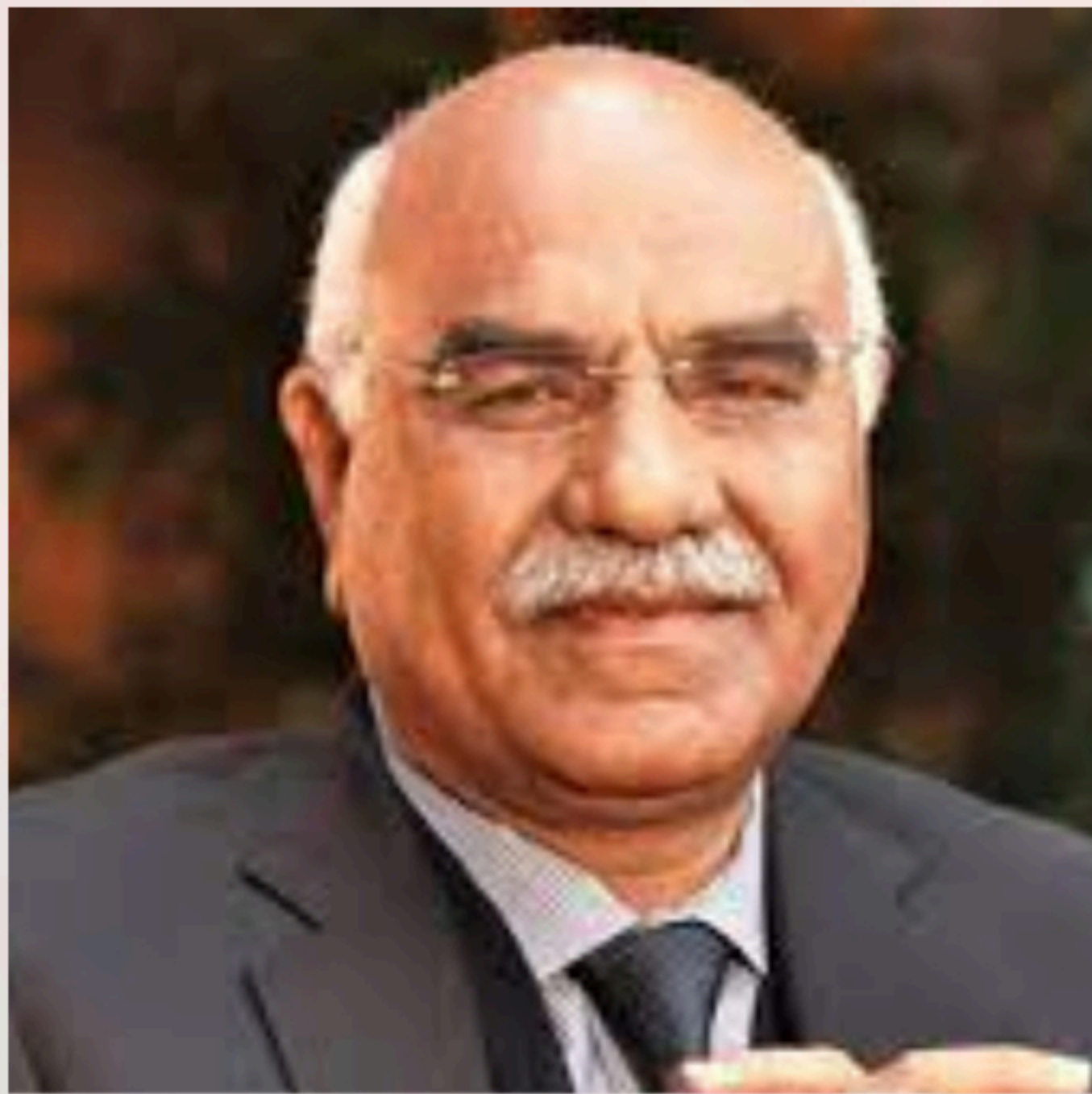


Interest-free loans up to \$1500 are disbursed for rebuilding homes
