Education

Education is the foundation for a better and independent life. Based on this knowledge we build schools in different regions and sponsor students through their choice of education and training.

Family sponsorships provide the means to leave poverty behind in the long-term and lead a self-determined life.

Helping people to help themselves is our overriding aim.

The most effective help is always that which puts people in the position to shape their own lives free of need.





Health

Projekt Burma e.V. supports activities to establish a sustainable public health system in Myanmar. With the construction of rural treatment centers and small hospitals as well as training staff, we can significantly improve medical care for the general population.

Our main focus is on women and children, as Myanmar has a high maternal and infant mortality rate. 282 out of every 100.000 women die before, during or after giving birth, often simply because a treatment center is too far away to reach in time.

Disaster Relief

Myanmar is a disaster-prone area. Regardless the cause of the disaster, it is always the people that suffer the consequences. Particularly in these situations it is paramount to assist the affected population with good medical assistance, appropriate food supplies, hygiene measures as in sanitation facilities and hygiene articles.

Through our on-site operations and cooperation with local organizations, we are able to positively contribute to the improvement of disaster situations, so that a life in dignity is possible, even under the most difficult circumstances.



Water & Hygiene

Access to clean water is a human right. Polluted drinking water is one of the leading causes of death for children under the age of 3. Myanmar has one of the highest maternal and child mortality rates that are directly linked to inadequate nutrition, hygiene and sanitation. (Source Unicef 2017)

By building wells and sanitation facilities in our project regions. we ensure that people have access to clean water and therefore we can prevent many diseases like diarrhea.



As a small non-profit non-governmental organization in Myanmar, countless tasks need to be performed "behind the scenes" on a daily basis.

Here in Germany, we give account to our members, our donors and the German tax authorities on how we have spent our financial contributions. In Myanmar we give account to our beneficiaries. The challenge lies in ensuring all that all parties concerned get a say in our decisions. In addition, we must recognize that intercultural encounters can lead to misunderstandings. This of course requires particular sensitivity on both sides. Therefore, the basis of our communication is cooperation full of respect and partnership and an open and honest communication in order to provide true confidence.
