We operate along Kenya's South Coast and work closely with a wide range of partners, both national and international.

Achievements

To date our focus has been mostly marine conservation, but from 2022 we will be expanding our programmes to encompass all aspects of conservation.

So far we have;

- Engaged over 2,500 national and international students in our conservation education programmes.
- Partnered and collaborated with 12 conservation based organisations and community groups.
- Created the annual Diani Sea Turtle Festival, the only conservation based festival along the south coast. We hold this event every June and bring in at least 200 students from the area to join us on the day.
- Organised and participated in over 50 beach clean ups.
- Created and shared multiple free online educational resources.
- Run year-long education programmes with various schools and colleges. From afterschool clubs and field trips, to weekly lessons and workshops.
