For this reason, we have tirelessly dedicated ourselves to establishing alliances with organizations in the areas with the highest population rates in a situation of mobility in Mexico, such as the city of Tijuana.

Despite the difficulties, we have managed to establish strategic alliances in that region. These alliances have been essential to identifying and contacting migrants and refugees in the target locations and designing a training plan adapted to their needs. These efforts will allow us to reach a greater number of people who today need to strengthen their skills to empower themselves economically and substantially improve their lives.
