About Domine

Domine is the only organization for the promotion of women's rights in all of Dalmatia, & one of the most visible organizations in all Croatia.

Domine employs 4 women, 7 outside experts, & has more than 60 volunteers, many being young women.

Domine has 5 major programs including :

- program offering counseling and legal services
- education & research program
- advocacy program
- women's empowerment program
- program for the youth in our community to bridge the gap between education and women's rights.

END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

Violence against women is any act of gender-based violence that results in or may result in the physical, sexual, or psychological injury or suffering to a woman

types of violence

ECONOMICAL VIOLENCE

Prohibition or disabling of the use of joint or personal property, disposition of personal income or property acquired through personal work or inheritance, disabling employment, deprivation of funds for the maintenance of a joint household and for the care of children.

SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Sexual violence is any attempt to perform a sexual act, unwanted sexual comment, or suggestion directed against a person and their sexuality, which may be committed by another person regardless of the relationship with the victim or the condition in which they find themselves. It is characterized by the use of force, threats, or blackmail to endanger the welfare and/or life of the victim or those close to her.

PHYSICAL VIOLENCE

Any physical violence, i.e. the use of physical force regardless of whether a bodily injury occurred or not.

PSYCHOLOGICAL VIOLENCE

Any form of behavior that has caused the victim a violation of dignity or anxiety.

WHO TO CONTACT

If you are in danger or in fear, **contact the police on 112!**

The police are obliged to respond to every report of domestic violence. In addition to the police, you can report the violence to a social welfare center, the state attorney's office, a health organization, or you can contact one of the civil society organizations that you believe can support you.

CALL DOMINE

There are a number of civil society organizations in Croatia that provide assistance and support to victims of domestic violence. Domine is the only organization in the whole of Dalmatia that has an autonomous counseling center for women victims of violence and victims of domestic violence.

The professional team of our Counseling Center consists of psychologists, professional associates, lawyers, and volunteers who are trained to work with survivors of violence. Their professional support is available to all victims of violence in need.
