



STUDENT SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM: TARKWA BREMAN GIRLS' SCHOOL (TBGS)



Together with cocoa farmers, we are changing the odds for pre-schoolers in rural communities.

In 2016, Cocoa360 established the Tarkwa Breman Girls' School (TBGS), a primary school that allows parents to volunteer on Cocoa360's community cocoa farm in exchange for tuition-free early childhood education for their daughters. TBGS currently has 270 students enrolled from Nursery 1 to Class 5, with a new class of 30 pre-schoolers enrolled each year

ADOM's IMPACT STORY

Do you remember Grace (Adom)? My brilliant cousin and elementary school classmate who had to drop out of school and forfeit her dream of becoming a nurse due to financial barriers to educational access? In 2018, we worked together to raise funds to open TBGS, Ghana's first all-girls rural pre-school.

Today, TBGS has grown beyond pre-school to upper primary, with 8 classes and 270 students overall! And throughTBGS and your partnership, Adom's daughters now have an opportunity to drastically change the narrative for generations yet unborn.

What's more? Adom now formally works as a full-time pre-school attendant, providing opportunities for her daughters and other TBGS students, which she didn't have as a child.

This is what makes us special as humanity: the magic of what we can do when we work together.

But we are not stopping here: we know that there are many "Adoms" out there in any of Ghana's 1300 cocoa-growing communities, and those in Ivory Coast, and beyond...

And just as we did in 2018, we shall come together again, to ensure that with \$455, any child who is admitted into TBGS will have every resource to achieve their fullest potential.

Let's make this happen.

THE COST OF EDUCATION:

The cost of sending a student to TBGS for one year is \$455 or 5,915 GHC. That means it costs just \$38 or 493 GHC a month to empower a student with quality early childhood education.
