According to official reports stray dogs' population in Loreto is around six hundred and increasing every day as the culture of sterilization and responsible ownership of pets it's still in development in our town.


Currently our work priority is to nurture and spay dogs all year around and have work an agreement with local authorities to implement official clinics all year round. We are also working with local authorities on implementing a campaign on radio and social media about responsible ownership of pets, information regarding the law about preventing animal abuse as well as how it will be enforced.

SPL will be sponsoring a workshop to local police about correct approach of stray dogs and sensibilization what animal abuse is.

The local authorities have accepted cooperation from our association to develop a brochure about how to be a responsible owner of a pet to be delivered by local police as well as an exclusive report phone line to report animal abuse to be channeled to the local police.

The local authorities have the responsibility to build a Canine Attention Center, however the lack of material resources as well as the inconsistency on the law and local and state regulation make this task at least 4 to 6 years away.

The aim of the project is to foster stray dogs while forever homes are found as well as while medical attention and assessment is provided. The project includes 230 sq meters of construction and basic services in a simple y functional lay out to host up to 54 kennels to temporarily foster stray dogs, hold sterilization clinics and adoption fairs. The following drawing represents one side only and the second will mirror this one.
