Aim: Our goal is to sponsor 50 children and young adults in Aleppo, Syria, to complete their education and secure sustainable jobs, ultimately transforming their future, their families, and their communities.

Where: Aleppo, Syria

Imagine a place where education, the vital key out of poverty, is just out of reach. After years of conflict, approximately **90% of families in Aleppo**, many led by resilient women, **are struggling to afford basic necessities**, including education. While schools and universities may not charge tuition, costs for transport, materials, and other fees add up, making **quality education inaccessible for so many**. Sadly, many children have known war as their only reality, with schools damaged or totally destroyed, and a significant shortage of teachers complicating the situation further.

With only two hours of public electricity a day, daily life is a challenge. **Illiteracy rates have** skyrocketed—from 20% to an astonishing 50%—and girls face even tougher barriers due to cultural norms. Yet, education can inspire hope, allowing families to dream of a better future without having to leave their homeland.

Our Mission: Crete for Life



At **Crete for Life**, we are dedicated to making a tangible impact on children's lives. We are deeply committed to helping young people **access education** through initiatives that uplift and empower.



Working alongside **The Blues Maristes**, a volunteer group active in Aleppo since 2012, we meet weekly with struggling families to assess their unique needs. **Every child's story is important—whether they're in preschool or preparing for university, we are here for them.**

Once a child is accepted into our program, families make a commitment to support their education. They agree to keep us updated on academic progress, provide receipts for educational expenses, and ensure students are safe and can focus on their studies. It's a team effort, and we support these families every step of the way.

Why Education Matters?

The immediate benefits of our educational initiatives are significant. Children who participate in our programs show increased motivation to attend school and are provided with a **safe haven** for socializing and learning. With the pressing lack of professionals in Syria, **equipping these students with skills**, like digital literacy and foreign languages, is crucial. Such education not only prepares them for the future but also provides a real **alternative to emigration**.


Monthly Donation: Your ongoing support can change lives. Just €40 a month can sponsor a

There's also a pressing need for physical resources in schools — €1,800 can restore solar power
systems, €2,500 can repair toilets for 400 students, and €3,500 can establish a linguistics lab to
teach vital language skills.
