Project Summary

NESODO will benefit 60 youth in 10 groups of 6 people. These teams will receive training and support to collect, process, and commercialize plastic waste. Repurposing and commercializing plastic waste and recycling or reusing plastic in art crafts can provide economical options to women and youth groups and help solve environmental pollution. The groups will receive training in agroforest so that its harvest help them get income in the future.

Challenge:

Pollution is increasingly fueled by Local transportation, fishing activities, and recreation, leading to increased plastic waste, which challenges water sanitation, destroying fish species and endangering human health.



The situation causes water bodies to have a lot of waste plastic. A problem that was increased by the COVID-19 pandemic and the use of inappropriate disposal of personal protective equipment, like masks, caused by a lack of education based on dumping medical equipment waste.

On the other hand, unemployment, especially among women and youth, is a massive concern for communities in Mwanza, Tanzania. Teenage pregnancies, lack of education, and women violence toward women lead to depression, drug abuse, raping, sexual harassment, and

prostitution and prolong the poverty cycle. This situation destroys the lives of many women, youths, and families. These circumstances call for urgent solutions.

Solution

Through this project, we will work with 60 direct beneficiaries in 10 groups of 6 people. These teams will receive training and support to collect, process, and commercialize plastic waste. Repurposing and commercializing plastic waste and recycling or reusing plastic in art crafts can provide economical options to women groups and help solve environmental pollution.



NESODO will also provide additional training to mobilize and create awareness among women and youth to work together on the opportunities around them, like planting trees and engaging in agriculture. The groups will receive training in agroforest to encourage and inspire them to plant trees that reduce carbon and keep a clean environment. These trees are planted in season intervals so they can be harvested to help them get income in the future.



Long-Term Impact

We will create and enhance 25 groups, each encompassing ten women and youth, to 250 direct participants. They will collect about 60 tons of plastic waste every month. Each group will include ten women or teenagers who will benefit from entrepreneurial activities based on their location to make the group and the project sustainable. These women and youth will receive training and support to engage in income-generating activities like fishing, crop cultivation, keeping of animals, commercialization of Sustainable Agriculture., the establishment of garments and establishment of business centers.

NESODOs vision is "to ensure health quality, better education, good morals, peer rights, and a better environment." Our mission is to "help people help themselves: we seek to restore the dignity and quality of life for people affected by diseases, poverty, abuse, and unemployment by eliminating barriers to success through innovative education, environment, and health protection, entrepreneurial development, teaching good moral, sustainable agricultural and community-driven aid through front line work, prevention, and advocacy, being a facilitator and enabler, galvanizing people and resources in Tanzania. Through cooperation, donation, and

contribution from development stakeholders, we can help more women and youth to employ themselves to overcome the unemployment problem, which is growing every day like a timing bomb.

So, we aim to create a vibrant local economy that employs youth and merchants in Tanzania. Aiming at helping 250 people to get employment in Mwanza region in Tanzania within five years.
