## ART & CRAFT

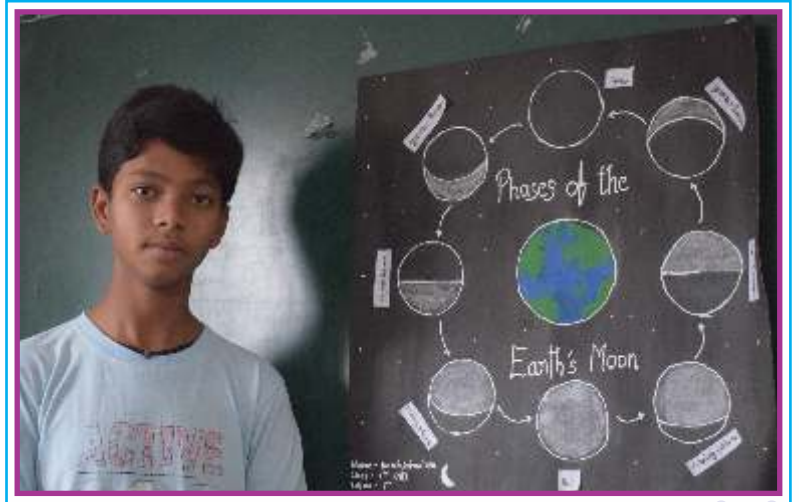
This time in Art and Craft, children learned to make bangles and made very beautiful bangles. And on Monday there is a drawing and painting class.
