ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

After school education

After school education will help students realize their potential, supplement knowledge and to compensate skill gaps. CHHASE makes sure 1200+ under privileged& tribal children remain active, motivated, and happy during their time away from school. Educating the under privileged ultimately will make a change for whole family and future generations.

We promote academic success, pay school fees, school kit (School bag, note books, pen. pencil, geometry box, scale, color pencils etc to under privileged and to tribal children. This project will ensure the children education without drop-out. During 2022-23, 240 tribal children were provided with new dresses to wear also we provided writing material to them to enhance their writing.600+ children are provided with school bags and writing kits.





Tribal children never go to school regularly. Their main requirement is food three times a day. If food is provided, they can able to attend school. Keeping their requirement in view, our society started tribal education school, which is an after school programme. This programme provides dinner to 241 tribal children.. Education instructors give them free tuition. To keep them hygienic, we provide New dresses, oil, soap etc. This programme also gives awareness to parents about child labor, skills training, income generating programs and health camps.

TRAININGS TO WOMEN

Trainings are more useful when women start their own business. They not only lift themselves out of poverty, but they have a much higher percentage of putting revenues directly towards their family needs and they are much more likely to educate their children, especially their daughters.

Various types of trainings, such as Tailoring, Embroidery, Beautician, articial jewelry, computer based were provided to 100 women in tiruvallur & kancheepuram districts. In 2022 & 23, 750 women in sewing, beautician, CCTV installation technician and emboidery training. We have provided placement to most of the people in nearby industries and offices. So far our nonprofit provided 15950 youth, women and widows till date









DAY CARE CENTRE FOR ELDERS

The less privileged elders need our love and care. This project provide meal, medical care and recreation to 32 homeless old age persons. Every day we provide nutritious food to destitute elder, who are neglected by their families. Due to poverty some families not able to feed these older persons. Among 59 poor old age persons, some of them use to beg at neighbor houses, nearby locations to feed themselves. Our little contribution to the elderly make their world healthy and happy.









FOOD GROCERIES TO LONELY ELDERS

CHHASE NGO identified 57 neglected elderly people, 12 poor disabled, and 9 neglected lepers cured in Tiruvallur and Tiruvannamalai Districts of Tamil Nadu and providing monthly groceries consisting of Ponni rice, Tuar dal, groundnut oil, soaps, hair oil, vegetables & other necessary items. Groceries are delivered monthly at their door step by us/our volunteers. The neglected/destitute are happy for this kind of help & able to eat food timely and healthy.









DISASTER MANAGEMENT

We are in forefront, whenever disaster oocurs. We have provided relief to the victims of Fani, Gajacyclon, Vardha cyclone and Chennai floods, Covid-19 relief and rehabilitation Etc.



In the month of june,2022 & Jan,23 we have provided ration kits, blankets, towels and saris to 62 blind families in maraimalai nagar.









During Nov,2022, Tamil nadu met with continuous heavy rains. Due to this heavy rains & Covid 19, many poor became jobless and daily wage workers lost their source of income. We have provided ration kits and blankets to 500 victims families at Kannur,vasanampet, mapped, govindamaedu, korukkambedu, eraiyamangalam villages.
