What is Qurbani?

Qurbani, also known as Udhiyah in Arabic, is the ritual sacrifice of an animal performed by Muslims during the Islamic festival of Eid-ul-Adha. This act holds profound spiritual and historical significance, commemorating the momentous event when Prophet Ibrahim (A.S.) demonstrated complete submission and devotion to Allah by expressing his willingness to sacrifice his beloved son, Prophet Ismail (A.S.), in obedience to a divine command.

However, by the mercy of Allah, Prophet Ismail's life was spared, and a ram was provided to be sacrificed instead. Muslims around the world honor this incredible example of faith and obedience by performing Qurbani annually during Eid-ul-Adha, which falls on the 10th to 12th of Dhul-Hijjah, the last month of the Islamic calendar.

Qurbani is not merely a ritual; it is a profound act of worship, gratitude, and social responsibility. It symbolizes the believer's readiness to sacrifice what is dear for the sake of Allah, reflecting submission, humility, and detachment from material possessions.

Eligibility and Obligation

Qurbani is wajib (obligatory) for every adult Muslim who meets the financial criteria known as Nisab—the minimum amount of wealth a Muslim must possess before being liable to pay Zakat or perform Qurbani. Those eligible are required to sacrifice one small livestock animal (such as a sheep or goat) or contribute a share in a larger animal (like a cow or camel).

The Purpose of Qurbani

Beyond fulfilling a religious obligation, Qurbani serves a greater humanitarian purpose by ensuring that the blessings of Eid reach everyone, especially the underprivileged. The meat from the sacrificed animal is divided into three parts:

- One-third for the family.
- One-third for relatives and friends.
- One-third for the poor and needy.

This distribution fosters community solidarity, compassion, and social equity, allowing even those who cannot afford meat to partake in the joyous celebrations of Eid.

A Universal Message

Qurbani is a timeless reminder of the values of faith, sacrifice, generosity, and empathy. It encourages Muslims to reflect on their relationship with Allah, to be grateful for His countless blessings, and to extend kindness to others. In a world where millions face hunger and poverty, Qurbani stands as a meaningful act that nourishes both bodies and souls, promoting a spirit of sharing and caring within the global community.

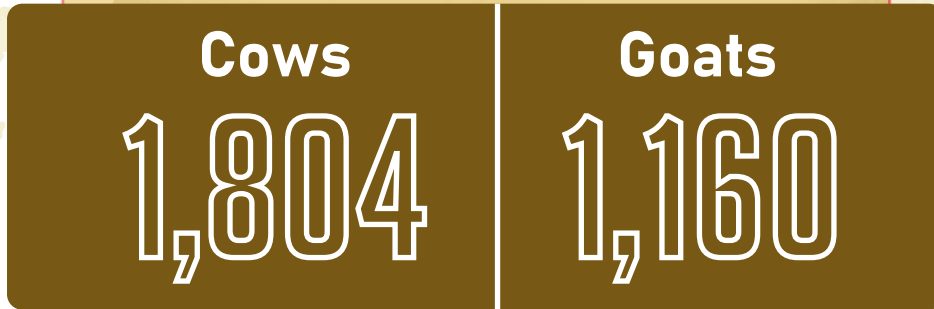

Cairo – 1000 cows

Slaughter Location: It will be fresh slaughter on Eid Days at Southern Egypt. Emphasizing the careful planning involved in pre-cooking and tin-packing the meat in Cairo, followed by secure cold storage to ensure a long shelf life of two years.

1

Initially meat will be distributed to 120,000 refugees in Cairo during the Eid festivities, bringing much-needed sustenance and a sense of normalcy.

2

Aiming to deliver meat to Gaza if borders open, while ensuring monthly aid to Cairo camps—reflecting a commitment to extend support where possible.

3

If borders remain closed, distribution of 155 tons of tin-packed meat will be ensured on monthly basis to approximately 30,000 refugee families in Cairo.

Westbank – Al-Quds – 75 goats/sheep

Slaughter Location: It will be fresh slaughter on Eid Days at Westbank and Al-Quds areas with the collaboration of partner organizations.

Fresh meat will be distributed to the Palestinian brothers and sisters living in camps during the Eid days.

Food Security Strategy for Gaza & Refugees

- **Food security for refugees** is a critical concern, impacting their health, well-being, and social integration. Access to sufficient, safe, and nutritious food is not just a basic human right, but a cornerstone of their survival and dignity
- **Ensuring a sufficient quantity** of food is accessible for the refugees. Meat will be tin packed with shelf life of 02 years. Processed and tin-packed meat ensures nutritional stability, hygiene, and availability during crisis.
