## **National Health Center Week (NHCW)**

The second week of August each year is dedicated to recognizing the service and contributions of Community, Migrant, Homeless and Public Housing Health Centers in providing access to high quality, cost-effective health care to medically vulnerable and underserved population in the U.S.

## **NHCW at Virginia Garcia**

Virginia Garcia's third year of celebrating National Health Center Week includes two unique opportunities for our community to come together; a community *Health & Resource Fair* and *VG Behind the Scenes*. This year, we celebrate Virginia Garcia's 35<sup>th</sup> year of providing high quality, comprehensive and culturally appropriate healthcare.

**Virginia Garcia's Health & Resource Fair** will be held on August 13<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 3pm and will bring together over 50 agencies to provide information, services, resources and education to the community. We anticipate serving approximately 900 individuals. This event will feature health and dental screenings, a car seat safety clinic, nutrition education, community resource information, and children's activities.

**Virginia Garcia Behind the Scenes** is an opportunity for community leaders, government officials and the public to meet the people who are working each day to serve the underserved across the region. On August 13<sup>th</sup>, at 10am and again 2pm, attendees will obtain insight into Virginia Garcia's strategic initiatives and programs, get a behind the scenes look at the clinic through personalized tours, have the opportunity to ask questions and hear stories firsthand from our healthcare providers.
