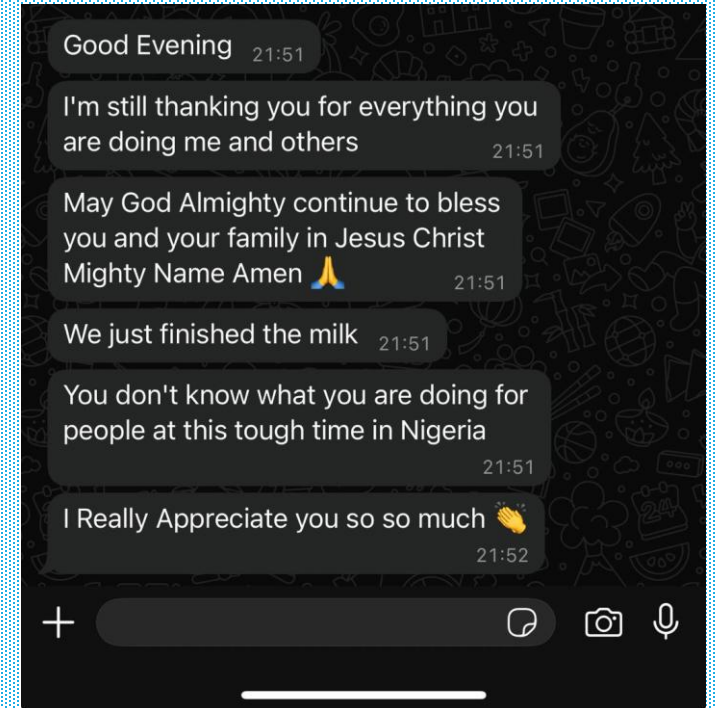

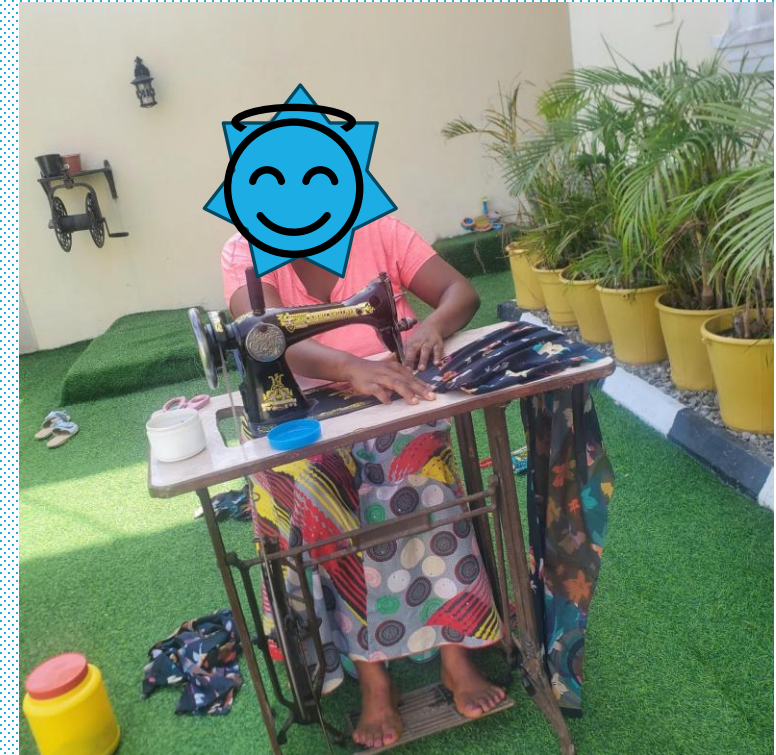
Empowering New Beginnings

We Testify of God's Faithfulness!

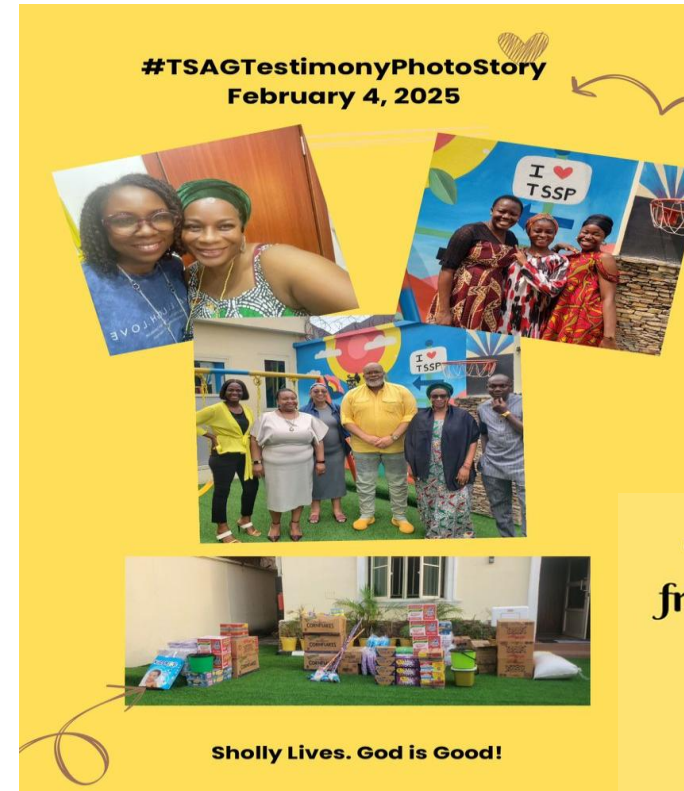
In Q1, we hosted a delegation from the South African Embassy. Their visit was nothing short of divine!

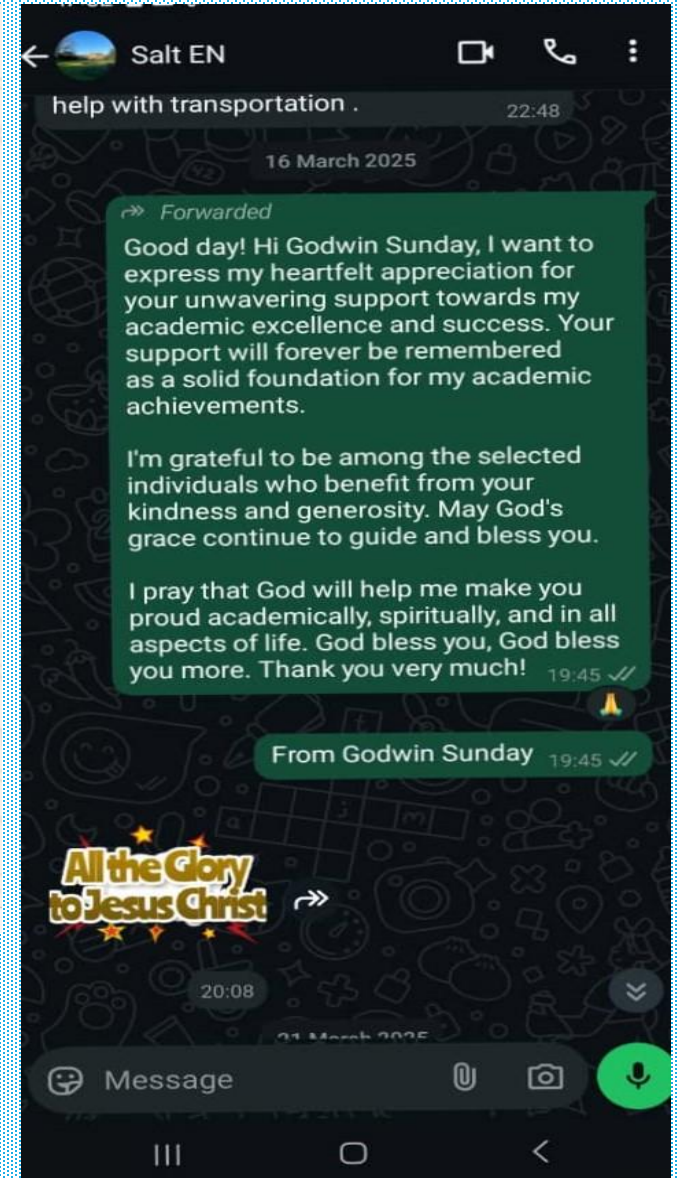
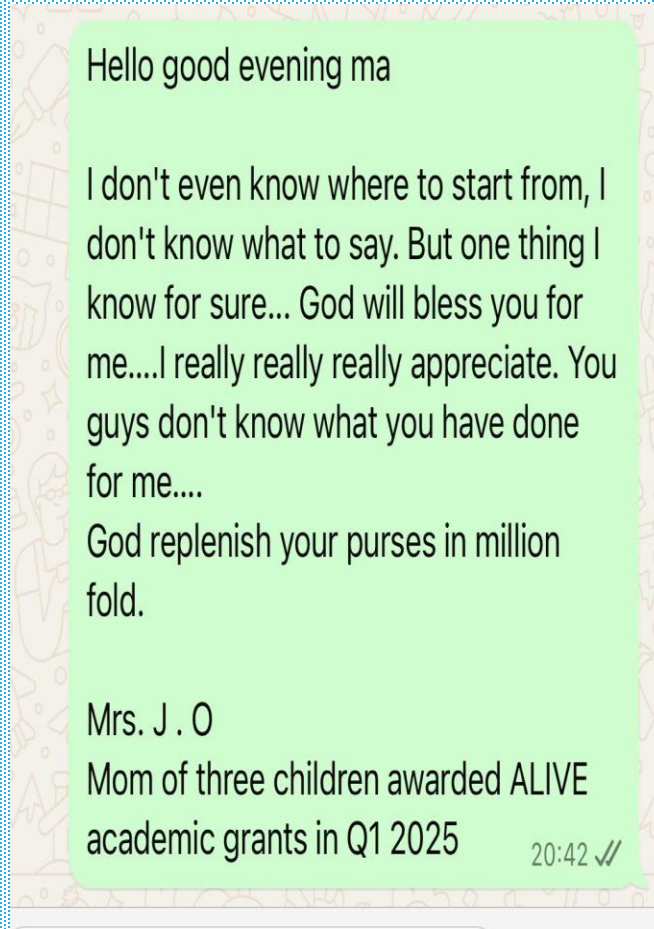
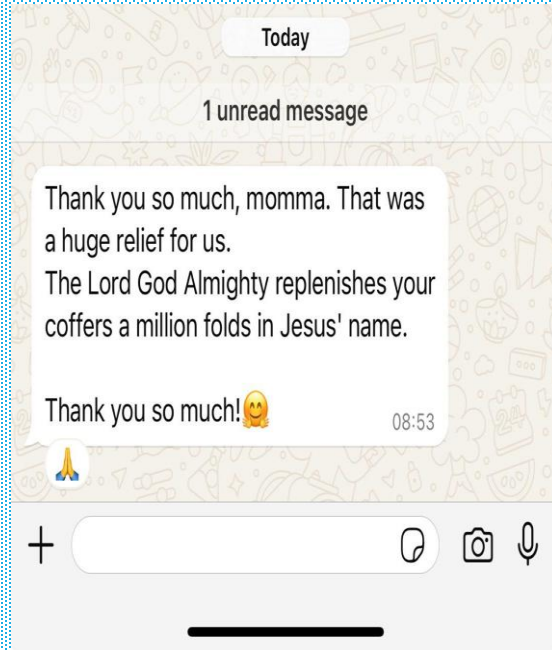
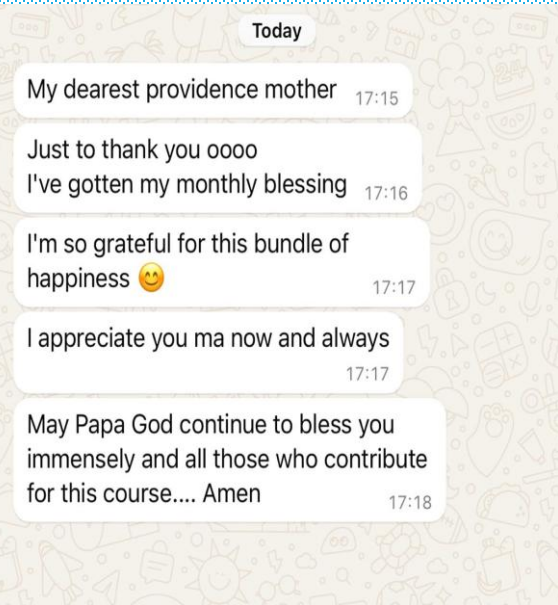
I thank God for bringing me into The Sholly Serenity Place. I experienced so many things while I was here. First, which is the love and care they have for each other and the respect they show for others.

THE SHOLA ADEFOLALU GASKA FOUNDATION: WHO WE ARE



The Shola Adefolalu Gaska Foundation also known as The Sholly Smile Factory is a nonprofit committed to restoring joy—especially to women and children—through financial, emotional, and spiritual support.

We were born from pain—the loss of our beloved sister, Oluwashola Adefolalu Gaska.

But through helping others, we’re finding healing. We’re rewriting Sholly’s story—not in tragedy, but in hope, laughter, and lives transformed.

Our Shelter – The Sholly Serenity Place opened its doors on June 12, 2021. It is a Christ-centered safe haven for vulnerable women and children. Since then, we’ve cared for 49 residents (women and children).

In May 2024, we launched ALiVe (Adefolalu Love is a Verb) to honor the memories of Daniel Oladele, Monisola Ramotu, Adeyanju Joseph, and Funmilola Sherifat. ALiVe provides monthly stipends of ₦25,000 for a year to vulnerable families. So far, 26 families across 9 states are being empowered by this initiative.
