INTRODUCTION

This project intends to support the Government efforts to Fight against human trafficking in Rwanda through education and land transit monitoring and helping potential victims find a safe passage back to their homes. "Transit Monitoring involves the identification, interception, and assistance of actual or high-risk trafficking victims at transit points (such as airports, borders, and bus or train stations) before they reach the destination where they will be exploited" and collects human-trafficking data, and assists local National Police and Rwanda Investigation Bureau (RIB) with investigations"

The Project period is 3Years from July 2023 To June 2026 at the total budget of \$ 1,421,786

The expected outcome is that:

- 30 000 youth population in high schools will be educated on the danger of human trafficking for prevention,
- 16 volunteers will be trained to conduct transit monitoring and manage monitoring of 8 strategic identified transit point to intercept more potential victims from human trafficking and helping the police in investigation to arrest more traffickers
- More than 240 victims intercepted from human trafficking industry each year will be assisted with the most needed services such as food, Healthcare and healing assistance and transport to get how to get a safe passage back home in their respective families,

 600 Children intercepted at risk of being trafficked will be supported with the professional and Training Skills (TVT) and Start up Materials and financial support to start a small business for surviving to reduce their vulnerability of being trafficked.

ABOUT EJO TWIFUZA

MISSION: EJO TWIFUZA which means "Striving for the Future" is a National Non-Profit Organization with the Mission of promoting social welfare and human rights for the next generation in Rwanda.

FACTS ON THE GROUND

The facts resulted from EJOTWIFUZA works is that from November 2019 we have now intercepted 252 people country wide to prevent them from being trafficked and our work has resulted in 4 arrests suspected Criminals and other 4 suspected cases are in investigation process in collaboration with the National Police and Rwanda Investigation Bureau(RIB)

- 4 Volunteers have joined to support our work and are conducting internships in the organization in different activities.
- The organization have been welcomed in the Human Rights Defenders network in Rwanda.
- The Country Director participated in the last meeting of Human Right defenders in Rwanda organized by the Netherlands Embassy on 28/09/2023
- The Country Director of EJO TWIFUZA has done a particular meeting with the EUROPEAN UNION Delegation at the EU Head Office at Kigali on 19/09/2023 on collaboration, partnership networking to increase the impact of the EJO TWIFUZA interventions.
- Staffs received a training on Digital Marketing in order to use the received skills in improving fund raising on different platforms.

- The Country Director conducted an emission on the impact of Climate change on human trafficking in Rwanda on the Voice of America press Radio (VOA) on 11/10/2023, 18h00.
- The EJO **TWIFUZA** delegation participated in the National forum on climate change and gender inequality organized by Acord Rwanda 22/09/2023.
