# Suicide Prevention Program Santiago



This year, Todo Mejora along with the local government from the Region Metropolitana, Santiago, in collaboration with other Non-Profit organizations, we started "Quédate" an **educational and awareness strategy regarding suicide prevention.**

## Workshops delivered by Todo Mejora:

- Literacy on SOGIE (Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity, and Expression) and the stigmatization, discrimination, and violence towards LGBTIQ+ individuals.
- Prevention of bullying and school violence based on SOGIE among students.
- Suicide prevention and the importance of mental health.

## Expected Result:

- In the past 6 months we have reach 2600 education professionals in 10 districts from Santiago.
- In 2 years we will train 13.000 education professionals in 52 districts from Santiago.




We received over 1.000 people in our Lolla Love corner in Lollapalooza Chile this year!
