## Winter Warmer Homelessness Relief

Dharma Care is an Australian charity committed to creating life-changing opportunities for the destitute and disadvantaged. Our mission is to facilitate lasting change, creating a ripple effect that benefits future generations.

Winter Warmer Homeless Relief Campaign 2023 raised \$56,944 and was an exceptional success. Working with our local partners, You Have A Friend, Pottsville Beach Neighbourhood Centre, Fred's Place – Vinnies, and Murwillumbah Community Centre, to ensure the resources have gone to where they are most needed across the Tweed region.

In 2023, we provided warmth and nourishment to over 920 people experiencing or at risk of homelessness across Tweed Shire - supporting people sleeping rough by providing new blankets, sleeping bags, tents, clothing, food and hygiene packs.



#### Winter Warmer - Fundraising Cabaret

Hosted at the Kingscliff Bowls Club, overlooking the ocean, the 2023 event provided the perfect backdrop for attendees to embrace the spirit of giving during the winter season.

The sold-out Fundraising Cabaret generated \$13,184 in income, donations, silent auctions, art sales, and raffle towards the total of \$56,944 that was raised.
