For 18 years, Blind Cat Rescue (BCR) has been a permanent, safe and loving home for blind cats and, since 2011, those that test positive for feline immunodeficiency virus (FIV) and feline leukemia. In those years, BCR has been a vital and consistent voice telling the world that that these cats deserve to live as much as other cats do. They demonstrate it for a global audience every day through our live online tours, 24-hour live cameras, open houses and volunteer opportunities. They are the best teachers by just being themselves and their example is changing minds and opening hearts.

BCR is completely donation funded from individuals, groups, and through partnerships. In addition to individual donations, BCR offers a sponsorship program and a sustainer program where individuals can sponsor a cat or support them with a monthly donation. BCR also sponsors a spay/neuter program in rural North Carolina that is funded by grants and contributions.

Our resident cats receive daily and weekly health monitoring, maintenance and care, as well as regularly scheduled vet visits, treatments and, when necessary visits with specialists in nearby cities. With many FIV- and leukemia-positive cats in residence, BCR has seen an increased need for and frequency in specialized veterinary care for related conditions. In the last fiscal year, about 20% of BCR's expenses are related to this care.
