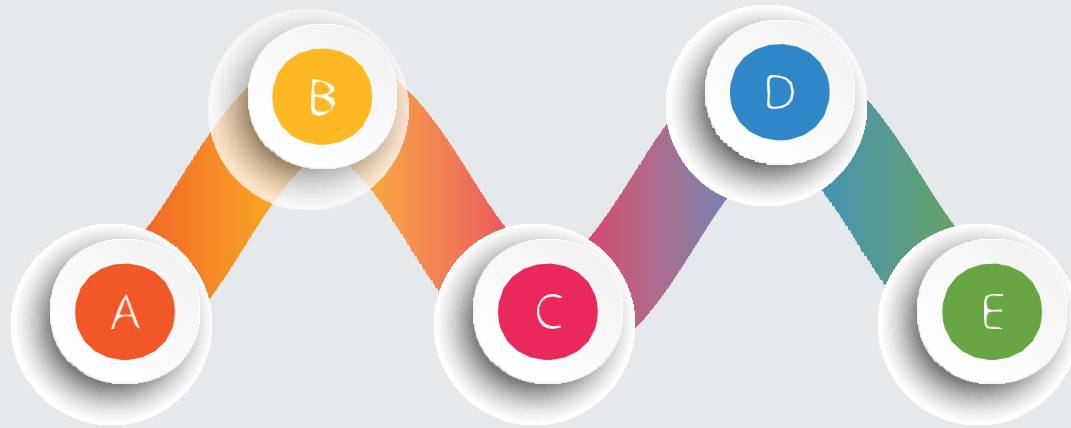

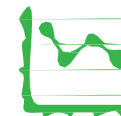

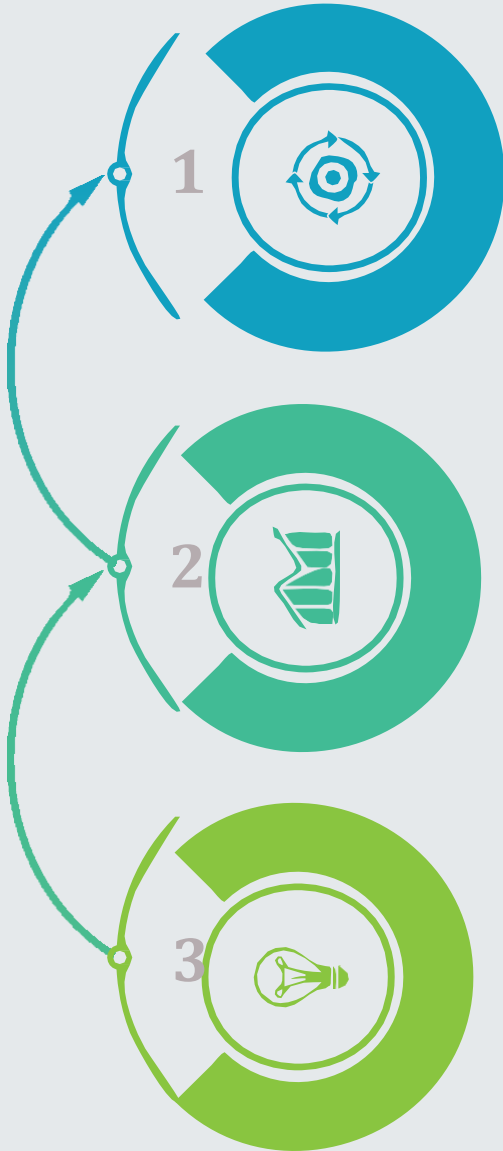


Why We Exist

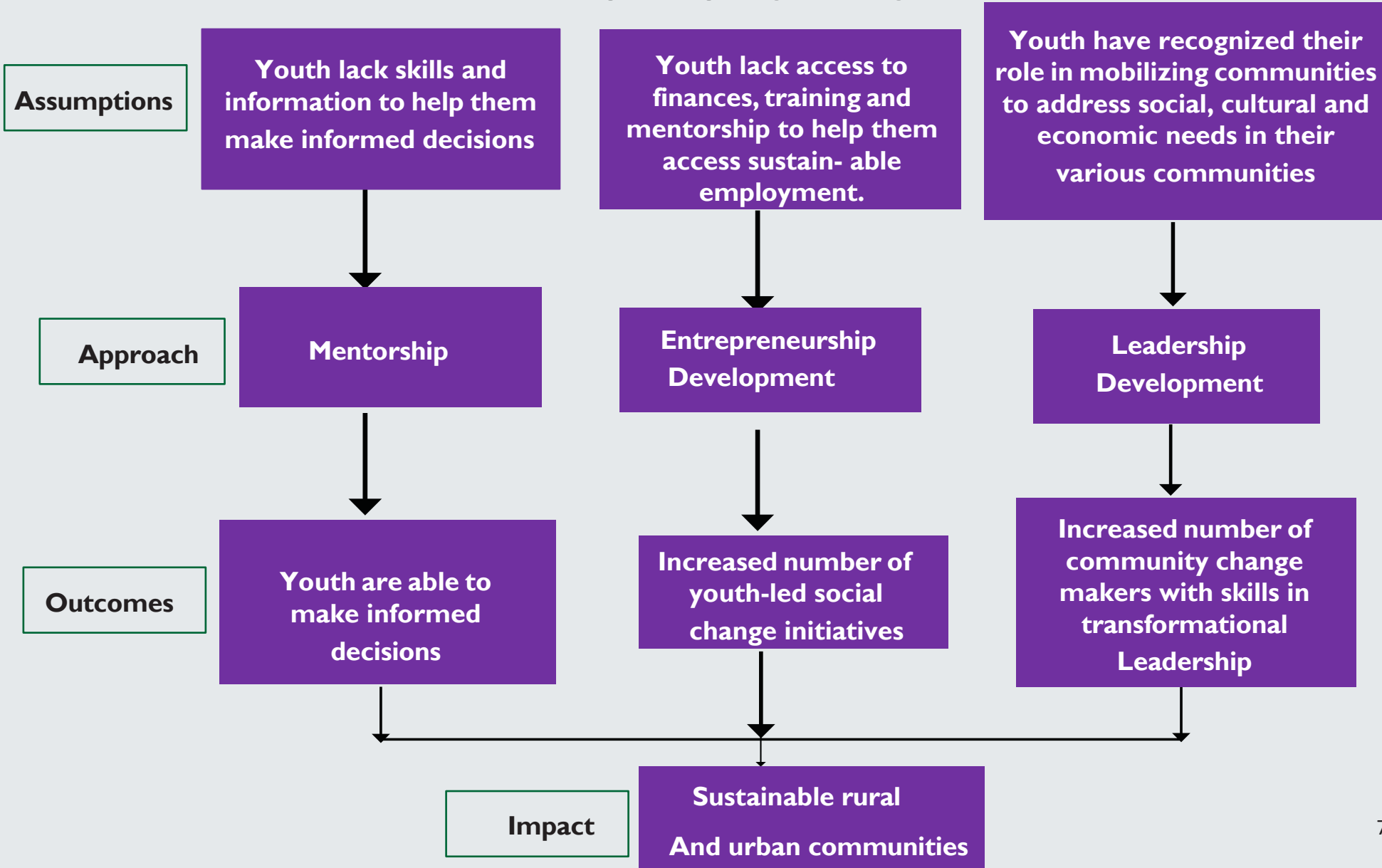

Saidika mentorship

We recognizes the need to provide them with guidance and support for personal growth and development to promote positive life outcomes and help them in making informed decisions. Mentorship is a vital strategy envisioned by Saidika Organization to support our target clients.



Sustainable Enterprise Development

Entrepreneurship is important in addressing high unemployment among the youth. Education and training remain critical tools in addressing the mismatch between skills development and job market demands.



Saidika seeks to promote a culture of entrepreneurship among the youth through training, mentorship, and support for enterprise development. Saidika works with youth, young mothers and women who are passionate about entrepreneurship, and are in need of skill, finances and support necessary for the establishment and expansion of viable enterprises



Leadership Development

Youth in slum and rural communities are often confronted with multiple social economic challenges. Even in such vulnerable and marginalized environment, young people have recognized their role in mobilizing their communities to address their needs, and drive social change.
