Queen Rearing: Rescue and Genetic Improvement of Bees in Greece

Bees are vital to both our health and the environment. They pollinate countless plants; 71 of the 100 plants which are responsible for 90% of the global food supply rely upon the bee-pollinators. Through the Queen Rearing program, our ecosystem is not only protected but is also getting stronger and more resilient towards the challenging climate conditions.

The Queen Rearing program is being implemented for the first time in Europe, Greece and it is designed in such a way so to set a benchmark for the beekeeping sector and be established as a "best practice."



It aims to utilize, rescue, and improve the genetic material of bees in Greece through a holistic and innovative approach. During the first stage of the program, young locals and new beekeepers are trained in the production of royal jelly, correct beekeeping practices and on a revolutionary genetic optimization method: From chosen beehives, very young larvae are transferred from workers' cells to artificial queen cells, thus producing genetically improved queen bees with the genetic material of the region. This way the ecosystem is protected, productivity increases, more persistent bee colonies are developed and a network connecting the scientific community with the local beekeepers is created. Simultaneously, collaboration between beekeeping community of the regions that we implement the program is promoted, and as a result their personal incomes are increased.

This process will bring about the complete transformation of beekeeping in Greece through the optimization of the regional genetic material and the development of more resilient, and more productive bee colonies.



During the second stage of the program, professional queen rearing breeders, called "the grafters", will organize queen rearing and grafting to produce genetically improved queen bees in beehives of the area they're responsible for, transferring the knowledge they have gathered to beekeepers. The artificial queen cells that are created will then be managed by the beekeepers for their own benefit, without any financial obligation.
