

Thanks to the joint project of Children of Heroes and Cher-17, we will be able to provide a month of English lessons for 270 children and reimburse emergency medical expenses for 13 children.

Inspiring story of the month

Anya, Ira, Natalka, Mykytka and their dad Serhiy

In March 2022, the life of a family from the village of Mylovo, Kherson Region, was destroyed by a single rocket strike, which destroyed their house and ended the lives of the mother and grandmother of four children. The father and children found shelter in an old house in the village of Stepanivka, Vinnytsia region. The "Children of Heroes" Foundation provided the family with help: food and hygiene kits, a laptop, a generator, New Year's gifts, shoes, a washing machine, clothes and stationery.

Despite the loss, the family does not lose optimism, finding the strength to move on. We believe that together we can give them hope and faith in a better future.




Programs of support
