



Chernivtsi region and CF "Children of Heroes" cooperate to help Children of Heroes

Chernivtsi region and CF "Children of Heroes" signed a memorandum of Cooperation for 2023-2024.

The partnership will help ensure a decent life for 250 children who lost one or both parents during Russia's military aggression against Ukraine and who permanently or temporarily reside in Bukovyna.

The action plan for 2023-2024 for the implementation of the memorandum of cooperation:

- identification of the needs of children in the region in a number of areas, including emergency, humanitarian, medical assistance, socialization and rehabilitation, education and development, housing reconstruction, etc.
- involvement of Ukrainian and international partners to cover all the needs of children.

Inspiring story of the month

5-year-old Eva Pastukhova spent half a million hryvnias to help the military

Eva's father, Maksym Pastukhov, has been defending Ukraine since 2014. He died on September 7, 2022, near Balakliya. On the day it happened, Balakliya was liberated. Eva was four years old at the time. After her father's death, she expressed a desire to help the Ukrainians (as Eva calls the military who defend their homeland), and her mother supported her in this decision.

For a year now, they have been helping various military units and volunteer centers, and the amount of expenses has already amounted to half a million UAH. This money is the pension Eva receives from the state. Valentyna, the girl's mother, is convinced that Ukraine's victory, not a new apartment, is the best investment in her daughter's future. Recently, Eva joined the volunteer team of the Svyatoslav the Brave Regiment Foundation and was presented with a real volunteer certificate.

Eva Pastukhova joined our Foundation only recently, in August this year. The family has already received priority financial assistance from us and applied for preparatory courses for school, and we are waiting for a tablet for the girl. **We are proud to have such conscious children among our wards.**








Programs of support

The second largest is **family helpers:** they are our direct and constant link with the families who help us to track every contact with the children and maximize our support to them.
























Over the course of a year, we scaled up and became the largest fund in Ukraine with such mission. There are more than 6400 children under our support as of today.


