The fundamental principle guiding our organization is the creation of a society that fosters inclusivity and provides a supportive environment, empowering people with disabilities to lead independent lives.



Project Explanation

The number of people with disabilities in Pakistan is increasing day by day due to different circumstances natural disasters like flood, earthquake also due to war & terror as it is estimated at 10% as per WHO report 2011. Due to stigma and discrimination, many disabled people are excluded from their communities and live in poverty.



For disabled women, apprehension and misconceptions about people with disabilities is multiplied by gender bias. Disabled women are more likely to be poor than disabled men and non-disabled women. Their poverty is linked to their very limited opportunities for education and skills development. DWA has conducted a survey in different union councils of Karachi and specially in liyari, as a result found 242 house-holds of disabled community. Poverty leads to disability same here the population of other union councils have also same number of PWDs.

Women with disabilities face significantly more difficulties, in both public & private spheres, in attaining access to adequate health, education, vocational training & employment. Promoting gender equality and empowerment of women and girls with disabilities is essential to inclusive and equitable sustainable development post-2015. The women were deprived of their basic rights such as right of inheritance, right of decision making in political & social sector.

The root cause these issues was poverty, lack of technical skills & typical set of attitudes and behaviors prevailing in the society, which confines women only to reproductive activities by limiting their access to education and other socio economic and political opportunities.



As a result women of this area have no social & economical identity. We did identify 25 women with disabilities, who were facing double discrimination for being women & with disability. They had same problems as described above but they were facing in high volume because it was misperception that women with disability cannot do anything despite opportunities.

DWA intends to remove such misperceptions regarding women with disabilities & prove the capacity & ability of women with disabilities through skill development training in different trades & equip them with all necessary stuff to earn their livelihood at home with dignified manner.

DWA proposes the project at DWA Skill Development Center under title "Education for 150 Women with disabilities in Pakistan" in Karachi for training of women with disabilities.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

TAILORING

Tailoring (Dress Making, Fashion Designing, suits stitching of kids clothes and stitching of females clothes in various designs)

EMBROIDERY

Embroidery (applique work, applique female shirt work, applique bed sheets and cushions, applique shalwar kameez, crucia work, glass work, basket making, Flower Making etc.)

Note: DWA will incorporate business development skills as course contents in proposed tailoring & embroidery. After imparting these skills to disable women, they will surely perform as entrepreneur and earn with self-respect and support their families.

Target

150 (women with disabilities and without disabilities)

Duration

06 Months total Duration 16 Weeks (4 months Course- 4 hours daily) Training

Criteria

Must be local women, with any disability, committed to learn skills and work for her livelihood, range (Criteria clear)

- √ To empower women with disabilities through education and skill development training i.e Tailoring & Embroidery, cooking to earn their livelihood at permanent basis
- ✓ To provide toolkits to women with disabilities to start small enterprise
- ✓ To provide career counseling training to find suitable career

- Baseline Survey & TNA will be conducted among Women with disabilities to ascertain the need of skills
- 150 Women With Disabilities will be empowered by establishing home based small enterprise.
- Training will be imparted to interested women with Disabilities to learn about Skills like Tailoring & Embroidery
- Dignity of 150 women with disabilities will be restored

- Ratio of Skilled labour will be increased
