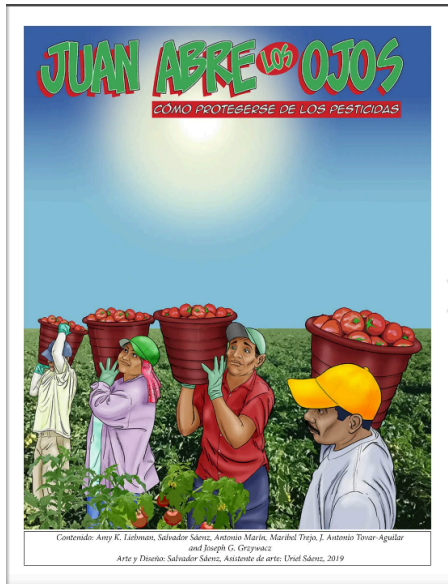
recognize potential signs, and improve identification and management of pesticide-related illness.

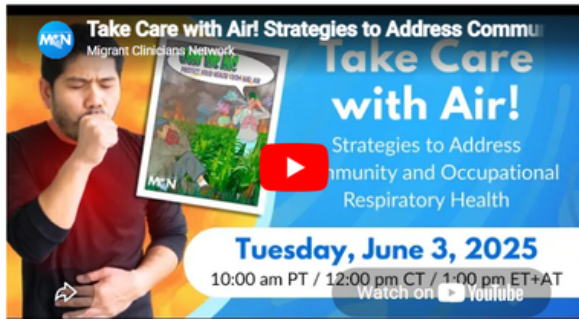
