Project Report: In DRC 50 families benefit from food assistance

In its quest to bring a smile back to the faces of the most vulnerable with a gesture, Save Life Make Difference targeted the LUTENDELE district, approximately 30 kilometers from downtown in DRC

A month before the distribution, the Save Life Make Difference team conducted a food security vulnerability survey at the college and its surrounding areas. This investigation revealed a need for food assistance. for a first tranche of food distribution

March 7, 2024, date chosen by the team and parents for the distribution. It was around 11:35 a.m. that the rest of the Save Life Make Difference team managed to reach the distribution location. A first team having gone there earlier for the installation. Everything was well coordinated so that the distribution began at 11:30 a.m.

The 50 families were there and could not hide their satisfaction.

We remain aware that these distributed food items, although important (as evidenced by the smile on the faces of these people) will not take these families out of the poverty that characterizes their lives, which is why Save Life Make Difference is currently working on projects which aim to train these people in certain professions such as breeding, agriculture and others in order to enable them to be independent.

The 50 families were there and could not hide their satisfaction. The beneficiaries received a basket composed of 10 kilos of rice, 5 kilos of sugar, 8 kilos of corn flour, 4 bottles of 1.5 liters of vegetable oil and 8 packets of food paws. Enough to eat for a few days.
