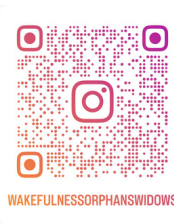

WOW'S Community Garden Thrives While Addressing Tanzania's Water Crisis

In the heart of Tanzania, where the need for safe water is acute, the community garden of WOW Tanzania is flourishing, bringing hope and sustenance to families in need.

With the goal of alleviating food scarcity and providing a sustainable source of nutrition, the WOW Tanzania community garden has become a vital lifeline for many. The garden, tended to by dedicated community workers, has been successfully feeding poor single-parent families, widows, and orphans, providing them with fresh produce they would otherwise struggle to afford.

But the garden is more than just a source of food; it's a symbol of resilience and progress. Last year, a well was built to ensure the garden has a reliable water source. This not only supports the growth of more food but also lays the groundwork for the broader safe water initiative.

Our aim is to expand the impact of the garden and the safe water project. With this in mind, we are working tirelessly to secure funding. We have submitted a grant proposal to dig wells for four schools and two communities, affecting thousands of children and their families. Additionally, we plan to provide water filters and install rainwater harvesting tanks. These initiatives are crucial steps towards ensuring that families have access to safe water for drinking, cooking, and irrigating their gardens.

Tanzania's Water and Sanitation Crisis

The urgency of our efforts cannot be overstated. Tanzania is facing a water and sanitation crisis. Out of a population of 65 million people, a staggering 58 million people lack access to safe water.

People, especially women and girls, spend significant amounts of time traveling long distances to collect water. This not only impacts their daily lives but also exacerbates existing challenges such as poverty and food scarcity. Underfunding of government projects, population growth, and extreme weather events due to climate change further compound these challenges.

Now, more than ever, access to safe water at home is critical for families in Tanzania. It is our mission at WOW Tanzania to ensure that every family has access to this basic human right, and initiatives like our community garden and safe water project are vital steps towards achieving this goal.

We are grateful for the support of our donors and partners, without whom none of this would be possible. Together, we can make a difference and transform lives.



Expanding Our Community Garden to Feed More Families in Need

In our WOW Tanzania community garden, we grow a variety of crops including bananas, maize, coco yam, beans, greens, okra, lemongrass, avocado, oranges, guava, and more. This garden is not just about providing food; it's about providing hope and sustenance to families who are otherwise struggling to make ends meet.

As we prepare to welcome 10 more families into our programs, it's clear that we need to expand our garden to ensure we can continue to feed everyone in need. We plan to add carrots, onions, potatoes, green beans, and more fruit trees to our garden to diversify our produce and provide even more nutritious options to those we serve.

Expanding our garden comes with its challenges. We've already invested significantly in getting the garden to where it is today, including purchasing the land it's on. However, with your continued support, we know that we can overcome these challenges and continue to make a real difference in the lives of families who are otherwise starving.

One testimony from a mother in our program stands out to us. She shared how she often has to hide from her children when they come home because she can't bear to see them hungry and knows she doesn't have food to feed them. Stories like these drive us to work even harder to expand our garden and reach more families in need. We've also heard troubling stories from the schools we are partnering with to provide safe water. One headmaster told us that out of 1000 students, only 300 can afford to eat school lunch. This means that hundreds of children go all day without eating, and with the water shortage, they often can't even drink during the dry season. These stories underscore the urgent need for our community garden and safe water initiatives. With your support, we can ensure that no child in Tanzania goes hungry or thirsty. When we first met Emanuel, the boy in the photo above on the left-hand side, our hearts broke. He was emaciated, dirty, ashamed, and completely beaten down by life. His dire circumstances brought tears to our eyes. As we delved deeper into his story, visiting his school and home, we realized that his situation was even more desperate than we had initially thought. Emanuel's mother had abandoned him, along with his younger sister Aziza and older brother Joseph. Their unemployed father, struggling with alcoholism and neglectful behavior, was unable to provide for them. The people in their village even went so far as to say that the children would not survive their dire circumstances. We knew we had to act urgently. We sent out a call to our sponsors, and we were amazed at how quickly and forcefully you reacted. Since then, we have witnessed the incredible transformation of these children, especially Emanuel. Thanks to their sponsors, Emanuel, Aziza, and Joseph now have a safe and clean home. They have enough food to eat both at home and at school, and they have clean, presentable school uniforms so they no longer feel ashamed. We want to extend our heartfelt thanks to all of you who have helped in the transformation of these children's lives. But our work is far from over. 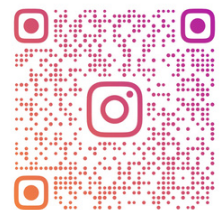
