We are excited to welcome four volunteers from the United States who will be serving with us for two months. Please join us in welcoming Sister Tia, Bella, and Brothers Emmanuel and Elijah. We are truly grateful to have them here supporting the children and families we serve.

We are happy to report that all of the children are back in school, and we are currently working to provide their scholastic needs. This includes books, notebooks, pens, uniforms, shoes, and other essentials. Nance and Saumu are especially happy to be back in boarding school.

Our volunteers have had the opportunity to meet all of the families. Emmanuel has begun tutoring Joseph daily after school in mathematics.



They feel safe to express their needs, and strong trust has been built—something we value deeply.

Our volunteers have also been impressed by the children's academic performance. The children were excited to return to school, and we thank you, our sponsors, for making this possible.

Sister Tia also highlighted an important ongoing need: many of our families still do not have access to reliable water. This is an area we continue to tackle as our work progresses.

While the volunteers are here, we are planning a special outing to River Trees for the children who have performed well in school so far this year. River Trees is a beautiful restaurant that is often visited by tourists, and many local children never have the opportunity to experience such places. This outing will serve as both a reward and an opportunity to build confidence and self-esteem—helping the children see that they, too, belong in any environment.
