Summary

Road accidents are disrupting the normal life of physically injured or crippled people. Which is creating their socio-economic problems. PATHWAY will work to rehabilitate all victims and bring them back to normal life.

Challenge

According to the data of survey organizations, more than 11 thousand people die in accidents in Bangladesh every year and more than 20 thousand people are seriously injured. A large number of them suffer from paralysis. As a result, their normal life is disrupted and they are also economically backward.

Solution

Providing proper treatment to the road accident victims and rehabilitating the survivors to lead a normal life. Also providing necessary legal assistance.

Long-Term Impact

Accident victims and their families will get long-term benefits through this scheme. There will be a change in society's negative attitude towards people with disabilities. Also, employment will be created through this project.

Story of works

Accidents have become a daily occurrence in Bangladesh. Hundreds of people are injured every day in numerous road accidents, the number of dead is not less. So, PATHWAY started working with road accident victims.

At the beginning of December, we learned that a person who was seriously injured in a road accident could not get treatment due to a lack of money. We quickly contacted him and admitted him to the hospital. We arrange full treatment for the injured person with a special discount from the hospital authorities. At present, the person is almost on the way to recovery.

In January, I learned that a person who lost a leg in a road accident needs a wheelchair for mobility. He is unable to buy it due to scarcity. When the matter comes to our attention, we contact him and buy him a wheelchair. As a result, much of his suffering has been removed.

We want to extend our hand of cooperation to many others. However, it is not possible due to our lack of sufficient funds and equipment. So everyone is called to unite with us and stand beside the victims of road accidents.
