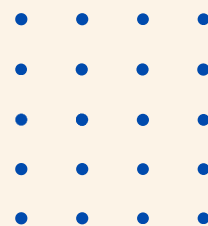

Stay connected. There is more to come.

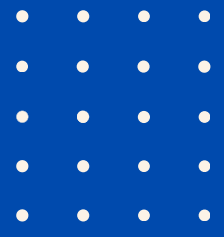
