



**Help the poor & needy with
Winter Clothes/blanket**

Project Summary

A large part of people in Bangladesh enjoy winter. But it becomes a harsh reality for the poor in this country. When people struggle to fulfill their rights, it is not possible for them to buy warm clothes in bitter winters. 'PATHWAY' has been distributed among the needy and helpless for a long time. The aim of this project is to maintain the continuity of these activities.

Challenge

Due to the decrease in temperature in Bangladesh in winter, the poor and helpless people suffer from a lack of warm clothes. Apart from the economically backward, people from socially backward communities also face harsh realities in these adverse times.

Solution

Through this project, we will distribute blankets and winter clothes to helpless and distressed people. This is a big campaign through which winter clothing will be delivered to the underprivileged in phases.

Long-Term Impact

Blankets will be distributed to 11,800 helpless and disadvantaged people through this project. That will protect them from the harshness of winter for several years.

Help the poor & needy with Winter Clothes/blanket



Story of works

Bangladesh experiences six distinct seasons, and while winter brings joy to some, it becomes a season of suffering for the poor. Many families cannot afford warm clothes or blankets due to poverty. For the vulnerable people of North Bengal and the coastal belt, the cold season often turns into a struggle for survival.

During the last winter, our organization focused on the needs of people in both northern and coastal regions. As part of this project, winter blankets were distributed among about 700 families in Kalapara of Patuakhali and Kurigram districts. In total, 1000 blankets were distributed, directly benefiting around 1,800 people.

Besides the coastal and northern areas, the winter blanket distribution program also reached marginalized families in urban areas, including Dhaka, Rajshahi, and Khulna. This year, through the collective effort of our volunteers and supporters, the program successfully reached over 900 families across Bangladesh.

Your continued cooperation and generous support are essential to expand this humanitarian initiative and bring warmth to more lives in the coming winters.

Cost statement and others

In the last three months, this team has successfully completed the winter distribution program in several districts, supporting hundreds of vulnerable families across Bangladesh.
