Kerala Floods 2026: Emergency Relief & Resilient Recovery

Project Summary

Severe floods in Kerala have displaced thousands of families, leaving them without food, shelter, and livelihoods. VOICE Trust is delivering urgent relief and long-term recovery support to vulnerable communities, including children and persons with disabilities. Your support will provide life-saving aid and help rebuild resilient communities.

The Problem

Extreme monsoon rains have caused devastating floods and landslides across Kerala, destroying homes, livelihoods, and infrastructure. Thousands of families are now living in temporary shelters with limited access to food, clean water, and sanitation.

The most vulnerable—children, elderly individuals, farmers, and persons with disabilities—face severe challenges in accessing relief and rebuilding their lives. Crop losses, livestock deaths, and damaged homes have created long-term economic hardship. Without immediate and sustained intervention, families risk prolonged displacement, hunger, and health crises.

The Solution

VOICE Trust will implement a two-phase response:

Phase 1: Emergency Relief

- Distribution of dry ration kits and cooked meals
- Safe drinking water and hygiene kits
- Emergency shelter materials and essential supplies

Phase 2: Recovery & Rehabilitation

- Livelihood restoration (agriculture inputs, livestock support)
- Minor house repairs and community infrastructure support
- Psycho-social care and community resilience building

Inclusive Approach

Special focus will be given to persons with disabilities and other high-risk groups to ensure equitable access to aid.

Project Goal

Raise \$25,000 (₹20 Lakhs approx.) to support **1,000 flood-affected families** with immediate relief and long-term recovery assistance.

Activities & Timeline

Month 1 (Immediate Response)

- Identify affected communities
- Distribute food, water, and emergency kits
- Set up coordination with local stakeholders

Months 2-3 (Stabilization)

- Continue relief distribution
- Begin livelihood restoration support
- Provide hygiene and health awareness

Months 4-6 (Recovery Phase)

- Support house repairs
 - Provide livestock/agriculture inputs
 - Deliver psycho-social and community support
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Budget Breakdown (\$25,000)

- Emergency Food & Water Support – \$8,000
 - Hygiene & Survival Kits – \$4,000
 - Temporary Shelter Support – \$3,000
 - Livelihood Restoration (farming/livestock) – \$6,000
 - Rehabilitation & Community Support – \$3,000
 - Monitoring, Logistics & Administration – \$1,000
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Expected Impact

- **1,000 families** receive emergency food and relief support
 - **5,000+ individuals** gain access to safe water and hygiene kits
 - **300 families** supported in restoring livelihoods
 - **150 homes** receive repair assistance
 - **200 persons with disabilities** receive targeted support
