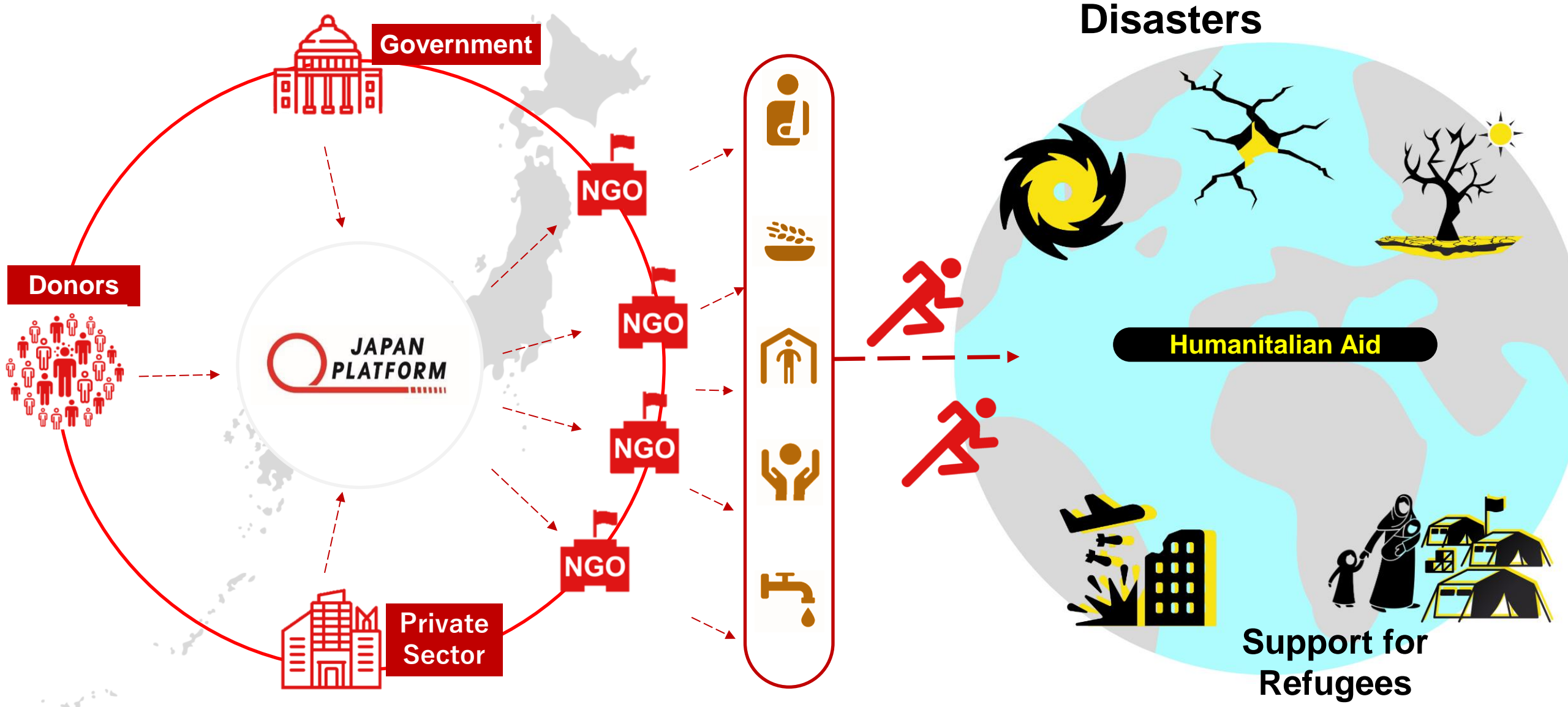




After a Year from the day

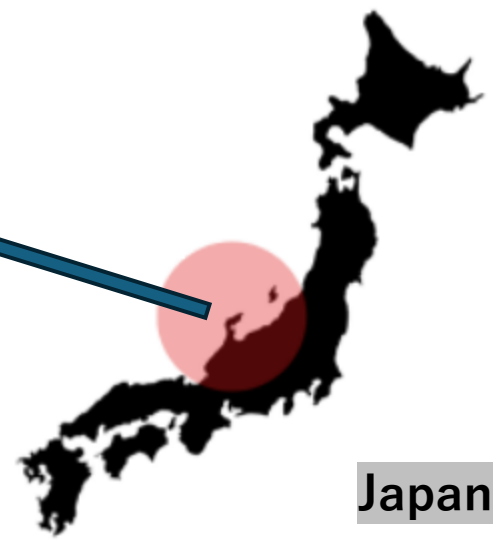
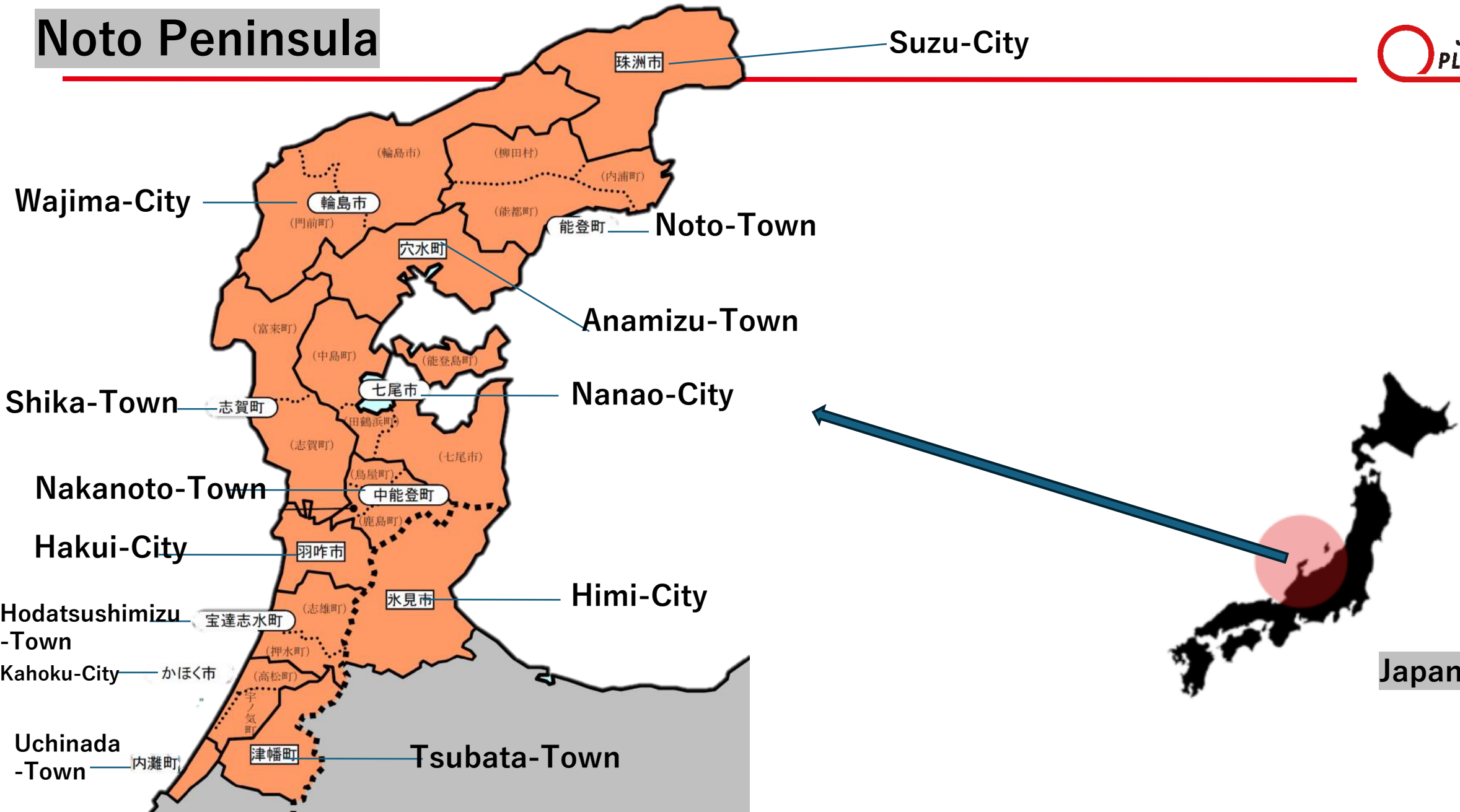

The Peace Boat Disaster Relief Center (PBV) has been providing food assistance through the kitchen car "Hoover" since right after the quake. Activities in the Otani area of **Suzu City** started in May by PBV and JPF is supporting this project since October 2024.

This area is far from the urban center, making it difficult for those affected to obtain food and daily necessities.



The only organization provided bathing services in the city immediately after the earthquake disaster was V-Net, which is currently operating two bathing facilities in Wajima City.

They are making such efforts to ensure that disaster victims can use the facilities more safely.

- Installation of non-slip mats to prevent users from getting injured in the bathroom.
- Installation of weights and windbreaks on the outside of the tent so that it can be used even on relatively windy days.
- Drying with multiple blowers after each use, as humid bathrooms are prone to mold.
- Preparation of waiting rooms in case many people are present.

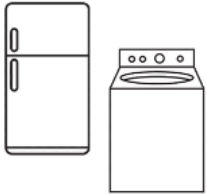
