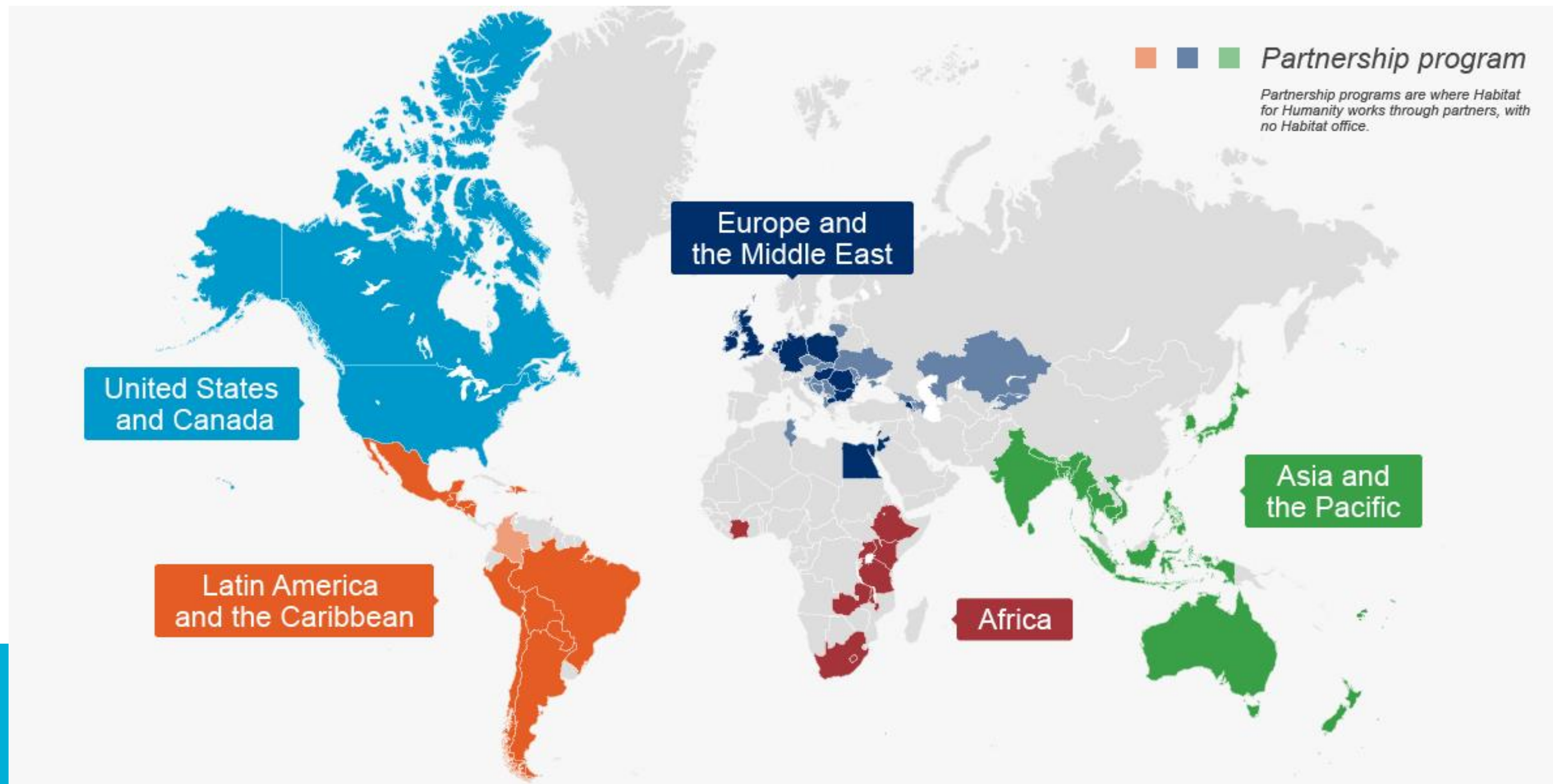

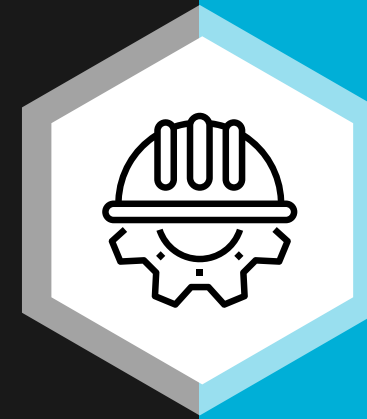

At HHM, we develop our work process in an integral manner based on the principles of **Participatory Design and Social Housing Production**, as well as the promotion and creation of tools that drive the development and active involvement of the families and communities with whom we collaborate.



How do we do it?



We support and advise on the self-construction process.

We seek change agents who break their cycles of poverty.

We provide training and technical assistance.

We mobilize volunteers.

We strengthen social fabric.

We generate alliances to have greater influence in territories with backlog.

Who do we help?

- We support families with limited economic resources, with **family incomes of up to 5 UMA** (unit of measurement and updating), who are in need of adequate housing.
- To organized communities that **still lack basic water and sanitation services.**

Water, sanitation, and hygiene

Investment in infrastructure

- Prior analysis and agreement with municipality and municipal water and sanitation authorities
- Allows for scale and impact

Water Filters

An eco-friendly and aesthetically pleasing water purifier and dispenser made from natural elements.



**100,000 floors
to play on**

Habitat for Humanity and the Inter-American Cement Federation (FICEM) join forces and launch the '100,000 Floors to Play On' initiative. Our goal is to replace 100,000 dirt floors with concrete in vulnerable homes throughout Latin America and the Caribbean by 2028





Dirt floors are perfect breeding grounds for parasites, bacteria, and insects that cause diseases such as diarrhea, respiratory illnesses, anemia, immunodeficiencies, malnutrition, and Chagas disease.

Construcción de vivienda y mejoramientos

El Derecho a la Vivienda es un Derecho Humano que permite a las personas a ejercer otros derechos; como el trabajo, educación, salud, acceso al agua, a la seguridad y a la privacidad.

¿Qué implica que una persona tenga una vivienda adecuada?

- Acceso a servicios básicos: acceso al agua, a sistemas sanitarios, alumbrado
- Asequibilidad: es decir que las personas tengan la capacidad para tener la propiedad sobre sus hogares; esto permite que estén protegidos frente a desalojos
- Protección frente al clima, protección frente a fenómenos naturales.
- Espacio suficiente en función de las necesidades específicas.

El 80% de la necesidad de vivienda en México es para mejoramientos (sustitución de materiales y terminados) y ampliaciones y 20% para vivienda nueva.

RECONSTRUCTION OF GUERRERO

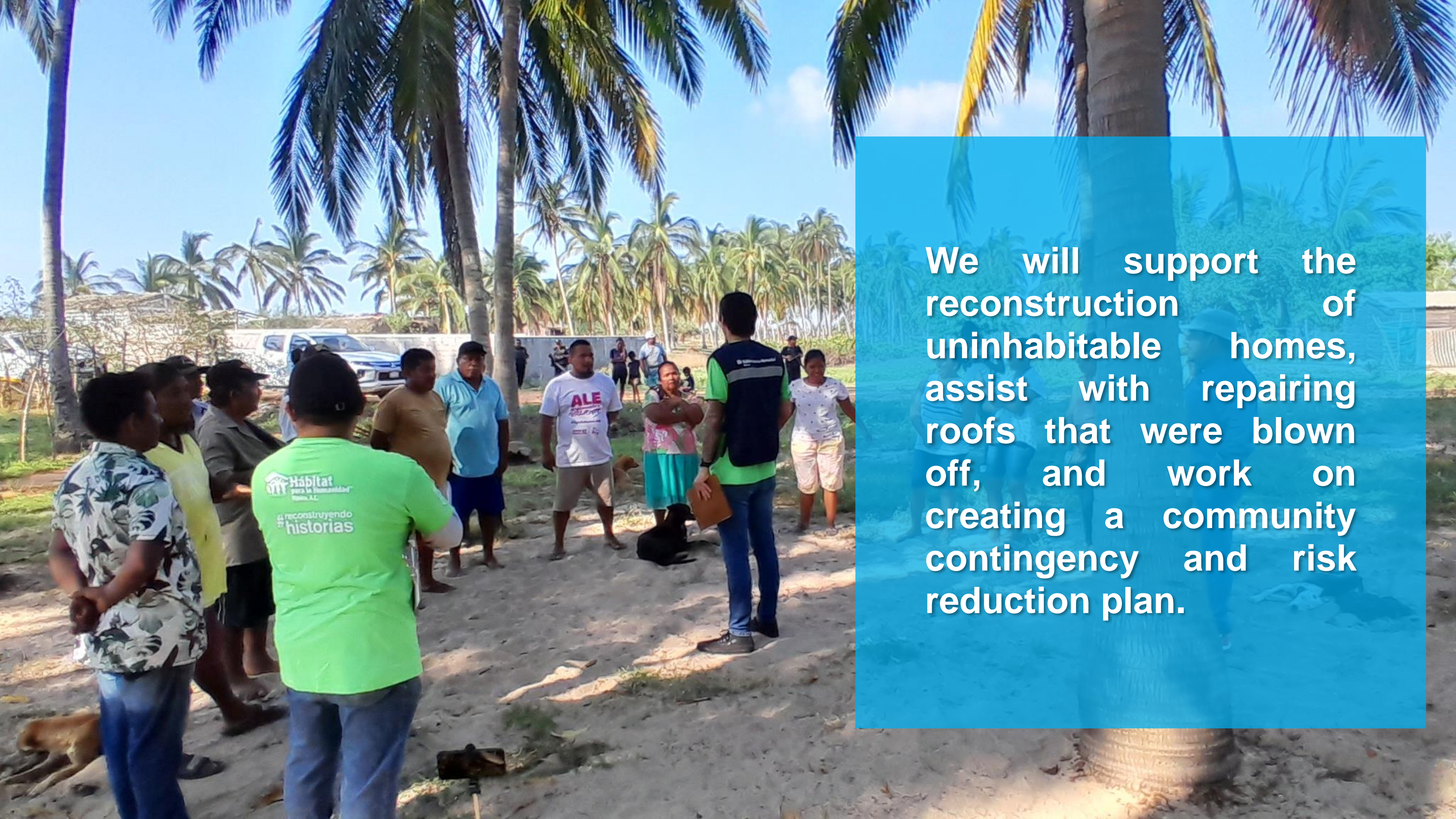
OBJETIVE

Achieve the reconstruction of communities affected by Hurricane Otis in the municipalities of San Marcos and Acapulco with a focus on housing and community resilience.

1.- Short and medium-term reconstruction of homes with urgent needs using resilient building materials and technologies against hurricanes and earthquakes.

2.- Develop community capacities for risk identification, preparation, and response (PASSA approach).





We will support the reconstruction of uninhabitable homes, assist with repairing roofs that were blown off, and work on creating a community contingency and risk reduction plan.
