Real-Time Electronic Medical Records Tracking

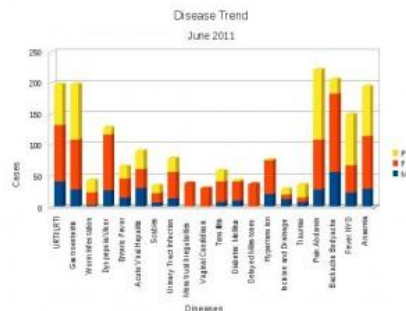
The main features of the system includes patient registration, appointment, patient history and medical records, including DiCOM image and prescriptions. Cellphone based services The system provides the following mobile services:

INTRODUCTION

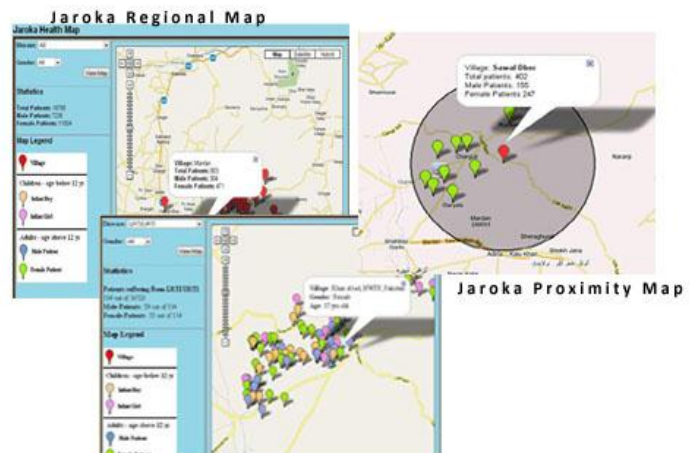
