



REQUEST FOR FUNDING TO HELP FINISH MULTI SPORTS COURT

WHO WE ARE

BaNgaAfayo! Translated? It means, "Show you care" Reason being that if it's too much to ask that people become part of solving a problem, can they at least show that they care? That in itself would require action!

Ba Nga Afayo Initiative Uganda is a nonprofit organization with a special focus on villages in rural Uganda. The organization is working towards the holistic development of the under-privileged and marginalized children, youth and young women in rural communities struggling to cope with the devastating effects of poverty and HIV through coordinated strategic programs in education, life skills, economic development, public health and advocacy, empowerment of girls and sports for development.



THE PROBLEM

The children of Nakaziba Village face immense challenges due to the absence of basic services and overwhelming poverty. Many children cannot afford the cost of uniforms, shoes, lunch, and books, and often turn to drugs and crime at an early age. In addition, the community is afflicted with an unemployment rate of 80%, an HIV/AIDS rate of 30%, and high teenage pregnancy.

ABOUT THE PROJECT.

The Ba Nga Afayo Initiative Uganda's multi-sports court seeks to address some of these challenges by providing a safe space for children to spend their time, reducing their likelihood of turning to drugs and crime. It will also combat the high levels of idleness and related risky behaviors that are prevalent in the community by providing opportunities for physical activity. Through the facility, children will have access to quality sports and opportunities to participate in sports and developing their talents, teaching them important life skills such as teamwork, discipline, and perseverance.

CURRENT STATUS OF THE PROJECT

Currently, the construction of the sports facility is underway, but progress has been stalled due to a lack of funds. We are seeking funding to complete the construction of the multi-sports court.





BUDGET BREAKDOWN:

The total cost of completing the construction of the multi-sports court is \$5000 USD. This includes the cost of materials, labor, and equipment.

Building materials (Iron bars, cement, aggregate, sand)	\$3000
Labor fees	\$1000
Equipment (Movable Poles for Volleyball, Netball and tennis, Nets)	\$1000
Total:	\$5000

We believe that the completion of the Ba Nga Afayo Initiative Uganda's multi-sports court has the potential to make a significant positive impact on the lives of children in Nakaziba Village in Uganda and the surrounding communities.
