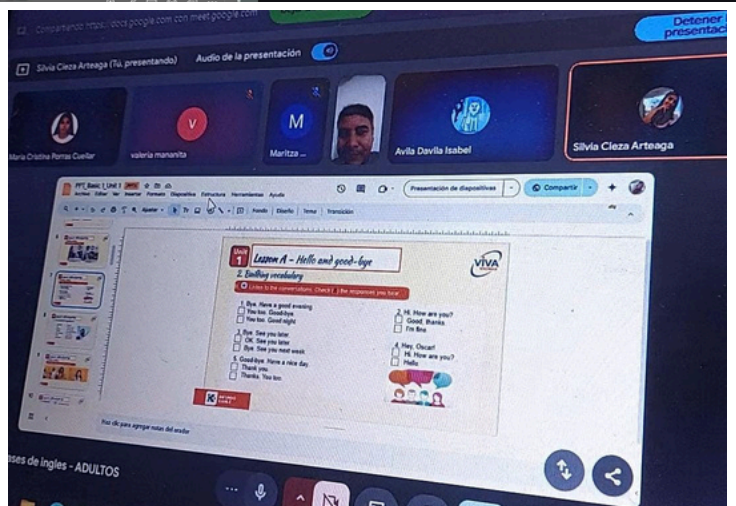
INTERN ACTIVITIES

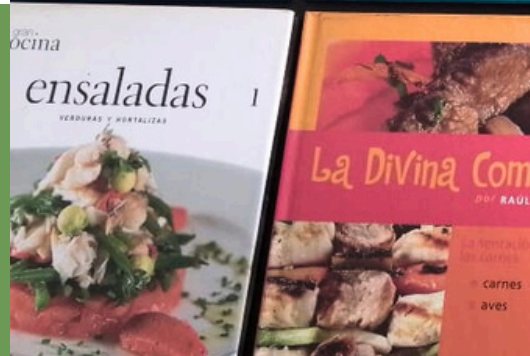
ON-LINE ENGLISH CLASSES
