2022 has been an incredible year for our NGO. Our Butterfly, Ainbo, Sonrisas de Navidad and Casa Ainbo projects have grown a lot. This year more volunteers joined our team. In the Christmas Smiles Project, we had 37 new volunteers who made it possible to help 1500 children and 120 families. Also in the Butterfly Project, which empowers women through education, we have had a total of 27 volunteers. The Ainbo Project and Casa Ainbo received 7 volunteers. Thanks to all of them we have been able to continue offering classes and training to more women in the Lima and Iquitos area. Across all of our projects, we have been able to help almost 1,800 people this year.

However, it has also been a year in which we have seen some very important people in our NGO leave, although we are glad to know that they will continue to grow as people in other spaces, there is a feeling of sadness because they have been a very important part of our organization.

Additionally, this year brought new beginnings. We opened our long-awaited Casa Ainbo in Iguitos in the month of July and we have been implementing it little by little.

It is a space where we offer English classes for children and adult women, where we give workshops on crafts, entrepreneurship, financial education, among others.

Opening Casa Ainbo in Iquitos has been incredible since it allows us to reach the most vulnerable populations and gives meaning to our work. We are currently helping women from the Rosa Panduro area in San Juan, Iquitos and also children from the human settlements Triunfo, Rosa Panduro and Peña Negra, all in the city of Iquitos.

Through our workshops, our entrepreneurship courses, our charity programs, Christmas Smiles, our Butterfly Project training, and our Ainbo Project, we are helping more women and children every day.

For the year 2023 our goal is to reach more people both in Lima and Iquitos and thus be able to help them change and improve their lives and their odds. I invite volunteers, friends, and associates to join our cause. The year 2023 is going to be an even better year. I know that together we will make it.





BUTTERFLY PROJECT

Butterfly project is focused on education, offering our beneficiaries English classes in the age range of 8 - 55 years.

During the year 2022 it has been challenging for our project, since it has been the most constant since the beginning of our NGO. All the materials for online English classes have been optimized, with a lot of help from our volunteers and teachers. Today, we can say that we have a more solid and systematized project for each of the 3 levels that we offer. During the year, 4 groups were opened within which 60 women attended our English classes.

By the beginning of the year 2023, 3 groups of English classes were opened, which seeks that monthly more women benefit.





AINBO PROJECT

Since 2020, the Ainbo Project, year after year, has been encouraging the beneficiaries to start up and put into practice all the knowledge learned in the workshops, and this year has not been the exception, Ainbo continued, to empower women and provide them with the necessary resources, such as entrepreneurship workshops: digital marketing classes, basic finances and many more, thus they can continue to develop their skills and obtain better opportunities. We can proudly say that we trained 36 women from the Nuevo Progreso Human Settlement, in Villa Maria del Triunfo.

Also in this 2022, craft and recycling workshops were implemented, which were taught in person at Casa Ainbo to around 25 women, during the 12 classes taught, 10 product lines were developed, while in Lima they were developed together with voluntary products for the purpose of that in the future they help support all the social projects of Imfundo Kahle.









