OVERVIEW



Hyderabad Council of Human Welfare was established in 1990 by Dr. Mohammad Rafiuddin, a young and energetic social work professional. HCHW attempts at empowering individuals, families and communities by building their resilience to cope up with situations and live a dignified life enjoying their rights and entitlements. We work with neglected children (living on streets and in other difficult circumstances) and marginalized urban and rural population, addressing the issues of protection, education, health and livelihoods. We have reached out to more than 1,27,000 children as on 31st March 2017. Renowned national and International Organizations, including Novib, Wereldkinderen, CRY, International Labour Organization, International Organization for Migration, FHI, Clinton Foundation, UNICEF and many others along with the local government have partnered to support our various initiatives.

Background of DMR School

While working with children living on streets and in other difficult circumstances, we have realized that all our efforts are focused upon curative aspects that starts once the child leaves his/her home and lands on street living all alone or in any other crisis situation. As a result, most of our beneficiaries need the services of Residential Care Centre and whole long process whereby they de-learn their learnings and gets on to the track of rehabilitation. The entire process of rehabilitation and mainstreaming is not only time consuming but also involves huge cost. Next, proportionate to the number of children we rehabilitate in a year, the number of children coming on streets is much higher. Thus, we started thinking in terms of including and addressing the preventive aspect also along with curative option with regard to these children. We felt that it is imperative for us to address the issue of prevention of children from coming on to streets in order to complete the continuum of care for these children. Available data support and the rich experience gained during the long period of working with children and their families confirms that children who are orphans; who have single parent; who have both parents but both involved in daily wage earning are devoid of care and parenting and therefore highly vulnerable and at risk of leaving their home and landing on streets.

OVERVIEW



It is observed that while the parents are at work, the children who do not go to school loiter in the neighborhood the whole day. As they grow up their loitering does not restrict to their neighborhood alone and it extends beyond that. It is easier for such children to think in terms of staying on their own on streets with other peers. Some parents realizing the issue engage the children into labor at an early age thinking that the child will learn some skills and at the same time add on to the family income. They fail to understand that in the process the child becomes more independent and thus it becomes much easier for him to think in terms of staying on streets on his own and fulfilling his desires which are not met at home. Hence, it has been decided to scale up the program to include and address the preventive aspects.

It is believed that engaging and imparting education to children is the best option to address the issues of protection, well-being and safeguarding their rights. We believe that education is the non-negotiable right of every child. Education is in fact the only ladder for the growth and prosperity of human beings. It is also one of the best mechanisms to ensure the protection of children while the parents are at work during the day time.



As a result, a beginning was made in July 2013 and we succeeded in enrollment of 80 children by end of August 2013. DMR International School is in fact a platform for such children to seek education on par with those children who can afford fees to seek education in reputed schools.

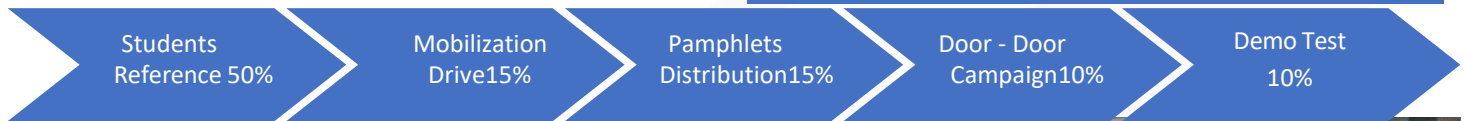
MOBILIZATION & ENROLMENTS

Mobilization

Mobilization process involves identification of needy and deserving children who fulfil our criteria for enrolment in school. Though it is an ongoing process all through the year; it is carried intensively for three months from April to June every year. The Mobilization team follows the following strategies so as to reach out the maximum needy children.

Eligibility Criteria for Enrolment

- ϕ Orphan children are always given priority
- ϕ Children from poor, disadvantaged and disintegrated families
- ϕ Children from financially challenged families
- ϕ Drop outs but in the school going age
- ϕ Children who had never been to school but in the school going age

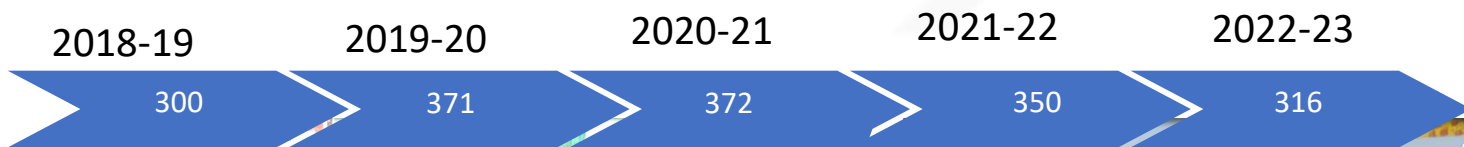
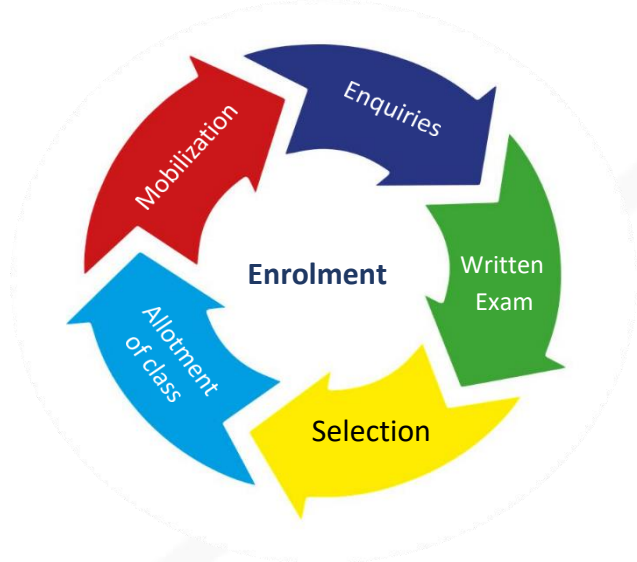

Enrolment

The enrollment process followed in our school begins with the parents visiting the school along with the Child/children. Parents are required to fill the application form and submit along with the required documents, which includes identity proof of child/children and parents and the academic evidence of previous school (if child is a dropout). If child is to be enrolled for the first time, he/she will be enrolled in LKG (PP- 1). However, a written exam is conducted for those kids who claim to have studied in other school and/or a dropout. Based on the performance in written exam, children will be allotted the appropriate class.

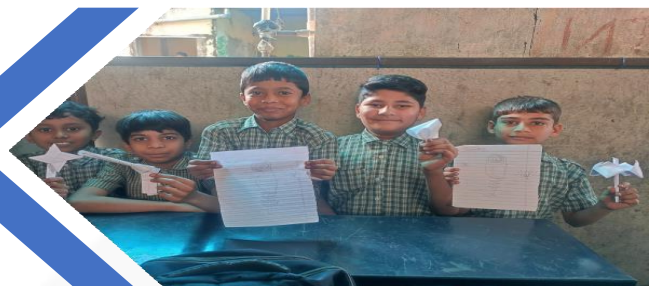
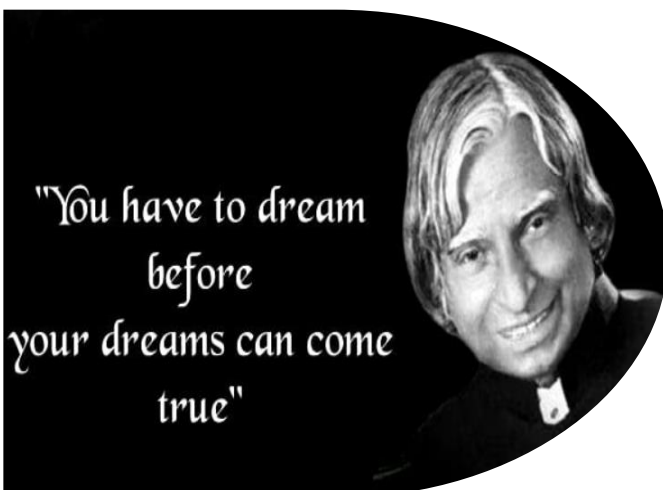
Academic Performance

The DMR School has successfully completed Nine academic years and is doing exceptionally good in terms of identification and mobilization of deserving children and their educational empowerment by providing free of cost education along with books, bags, stationary, uniform and transport facilities. During the academic year (2022 -23), 316 children studied in the school. The academic performance of these children is presented in the table below.
