


# Camp Programs 2026: Support, Growth, Future



The Children of Heroes Charity Fund supports over **14,500 children** who have lost one or both parents because of the war. The Fund's main goal is to help them cope with their loss and build a safe, dignified, and independent future. One of our key programmes for support, psychological recovery, and socialization is children's camps. They give children not only rest, but also a renewed sense of safety, access to psychologists, a supportive community, and faith in themselves.

## Camp Programme Results

- Since the Fund was established, **5,903 children** and **609 caregivers** have attended camps in Ukraine and abroad;
- The number of camps is growing every year: **from 6 in 2022 to 99 in 2024**;
- **336 children and caregivers** have taken part in camps abroad;
- We launched the innovative family camp «Svitlyachok», where even children from the age of 1 can rest and recover together with their mothers.;
- **In 2024, children with disabilities joined our camps for the first time**, marking the start of our inclusive camp track.

In the next slides, you will find a detailed overview of all the camps we run for Children of Heroes beneficiaries. Each camp is unique: some focus on psychological recovery, others on learning and discovering new talents, and others on adventures and life in nature.

All programmes are designed by qualified professionals with proven education and experience. We cooperate with camps only under clear rules — **more than 20 Fund policies** that cover everything from personal data protection to procurement and tender procedures. This guarantees transparency, quality, and above all, safety.

# «SVYTLYACHOK»


The project takes place in the picturesque Carpathian Mountains, where children from the age of one come with their mothers to find a sense of safety, rest, recovery, and opportunities for development. The programme combines one-to-one consultations, group sessions with psychologists, art therapy, and joint activities, creating an atmosphere of support and healing.

## Impact of the camp programme:

Reduced levels of stress and anxiety;  
Restored emotional balance and development of self-support skills;  
Stronger resilience in both mothers and children;  
New friendships and an atmosphere of mutual support;  
A sense of physical and emotional renewal through the combination of therapy and rest.

## «STRENGTH WITHIN YOU»

An in-house project of the Fund, developed after three years of studying the emotional and social needs of children who have lost one or both parents due to the war. The camp combines rest, psychological support, and socialisation, helping children feel safe, supported, and that they belong, and to start their long-term recovery after loss.

The programme includes individual and group sessions with psychologists, art therapy, development of self-regulation skills, managing anxiety, and building confidence. Before the camp, each child's psychological state is assessed, and after the camp, support can be continued for several months if needed.

### Impact of the camp programme:

Reduced levels of anxiety and tension;  
Greater openness in communication and willingness to join group activities;  
A strengthened sense of «I am not alone» and belief in one's own abilities;  
New positive emotional reference points that support children in their future lives.



## «I AM DA VINCI»

The camp programme is based on the international «Children and Grief» methodology developed by British psychologists. It combines psychological support with creative activities to help children take care of themselves, reduce stress, and feel safe. Children take part in group and individual sessions, learn to recognise and process their emotions, and receive tools to cope with PTSD. Art therapy, mindfulness, film therapy, and games help them work through difficult memories, creating space for relief and renewed self-confidence.

### Impact of the camp programme:

- Reduced PTSD symptoms (fewer nightmares, less tension and anxiety);
- Improved ability to recognise and name one's own emotions;
- Increased confidence and openness in communication;
- Formation of positive emotional memories as a support for the future;
- A sense of safety thanks to the camp's rules and atmosphere;
- Building internal resources for further work with trauma.

## «TERRA HEROICA»

The camp is implemented in partnership between the Fund's psychologists and the One Camp team. It focuses on psychological activities and art therapy built around the creative concept: Ukrainian land is a land of renowned heroes whose courage and deeds are known through the ages. At the camp, children and their caregivers receive comprehensive psychological support: group and individual counselling, art therapy, and evening programmes with elements of psycho-rehabilitation.

### Impact of the camp programme:

Reduced symptoms of stress and anxiety;  
Development of emotional self-regulation skills;  
Prevention of PTSD;  
Improved family relationships and a stronger sense of peer support;  
New social connections and a sense of community.

# «FRIENDS WORLD»

The camp offers a programme of psychological support, sports and leisure activities, and English classes, giving participants emotional comfort, a sense of safety, quality rest, and positive emotions.

It is located in the picturesque Carpathians, in the village of Tatariv, at the «U Bazhaniv» hotel.

The camp team consists of experienced teachers and psychologists with over 10 years of experience working with teenagers.

## Impact of the camp programme:

The «peer-to-peer» approach creates an atmosphere of support and mutual understanding;

Reduced levels of stress and anxiety;

Restored emotional balance and development of self-support skills;

New friendships;

A sense of physical and emotional renewal thanks to the combination of therapy and rest.

# «TUTOR CAMP»

The English-language camp in Truskavets is designed to help children overcome the language barrier and communicate confidently in English. The programme is based on full immersion: throughout the session, all participants speak only English with native-speaker volunteers and work with literary texts, films, and scripts. If needed, the camp can run programmes for two groups of 12 children in parallel at different locations — in Truskavets and Yamelynytsia. A Fund psychologist accompanies the children, providing group and individual consultations, ensuring not only learning but also emotional support.

## Impact of the camp programme:

- Fast overcoming of the spoken English barrier;
- Improved grammar, pronunciation, and vocabulary;
- Daily communication with native speakers;
- Greater confidence in one's own skills;
- New social contacts and better prospects for joining international education programmes.

## «ATLAS CAMP»

The English-language camp is based on methods used in British and American language schools. Children learn English through full immersion: lessons with teachers, speaking clubs with native speakers, and daily practice during shared activities and leisure.

At the camp, children take a placement test and are divided into small groups (up to 12 participants) according to their language level and age. They receive 15 English lessons with tutors and 10 hours of speaking clubs with native speakers. An important part of the programme is informal communication with native-speaking teachers during games, creative workshops, excursions, and sports activities. The camp offers excursions to Bukovel and nearby areas, quests, movie nights, parties, sports, and swimming in the pool.

### Impact of the camp programme:

- Rapid improvement in English through language immersion;
- Overcoming the fear of speaking with native speakers;
- Development of communication and social skills in a group setting;
- Creative self-expression through workshops and games;
- New experiences and friendships thanks to excursions and team activities.

# «STEM CAMP KUBOID»

An intensive five-day programme for younger and older age groups based on STEM principles (science, technology, engineering, mathematics). Participants dive into a world of experiments, research, logic games, and creative projects that build critical thinking, teamwork, and curiosity for science.

## Key components of the programme:

- Science shows and lab experiments (physics, chemistry, biology)
- Maths activities and games (bingo, problem-solving, history of mathematics)
- Engineering and art workshops (neurography, ink-blot art, leaf art)
- Project work with a final presentation involving parents
- Visits to science and mathematics museum spaces

- Development of STEM skills in an accessible and engaging format
- Increased motivation to learn through hands-on exploration
- Building cooperation, presentation, and self-expression skills
- Creating a safe environment for discovery and creativity

## «IT FRIENDS»

The camp programme is based on a proprietary methodology that combines learning and leisure. Children attend daily IT classes, practise English in an English Speaking Club format, and join outdoor activities in a picturesque mountain setting. They also take part in quests, evening events, workshops, mountain hikes, talent shows, and sports games. The camp has a closed area with swimming pools, modern cabins, and dedicated recreation zones. A special feature of the programme is horse riding and a full immersion into active, healthy, and engaging free time.

### Impact of the camp programme:

- Development of IT skills and improvement of English;
- Building confidence in communication and teamwork;
- Fostering creativity through workshops, quests, and talent shows;
- Promoting an active lifestyle through rest and health-strengthening activities;
- Creating an atmosphere of friendship, belonging, and inspiration for personal growth.

## «UKRAINE TODAY»

The camp combines summer recreation with career exploration for teenagers in various fields. Last year, participants tried themselves as journalists, developed critical thinking and creativity, and took part in mountain hikes, excursions, and sports games. A team of psychologists is with them throughout, providing individual and group support.

Last year, the teenagers wrote texts, filmed reports, conducted interviews, and debated Ukraine's past and present. Experienced journalists from the 1+1 TV channel worked with them, sharing professional experience and inspiring them with their own stories.

### Impact of the camp programme:

- Forming an understanding of different professions and one's own strengths (including creating a first mini-project/portfolio);
- Developing critical thinking and the ability to express one's views;
- Stabilising the emotional state and learning self-regulation;
- Strengthening trust in professionals and adults;
- Encouraging teamwork and new friendships.

# «SMART MONEY CAMP»

An educational and practical space where teenagers learn to handle money confidently, understand economic processes, and build healthy financial habits. The programme is designed to use real-life examples, practical exercises, and expert support to prepare them for adult life and financial independence.

The programme consists of five 2-hour sessions and an interactive Q&A block. Children learn the basics of financial planning, how to set realistic goals, create a personal budget, analyse risks, and build an investment portfolio. A special focus is placed on investment opportunities in Ukraine and abroad. The sessions are led by professional financial planners from iPlan.ua and practising investors, who share not only knowledge but also personal experience that inspires the teenagers.

## Impact of the camp programme:

- Building a basic understanding of the financial system and money management principles;
- Developing responsibility for one's own financial decisions;
- Learning independence: budgeting, managing expenses, and saving money;
- Helping to shape informed financial and career goals;
- Increasing the chances of financial stability and a confident future.

## «LEADERS OF CHANGE»

The camp helps young people develop a sense of responsibility for their environment and motivates them to take an active part in public life. Children both rest and learn how to implement socially important projects aimed at positive change in the country.

The programme combines trainings from experts in ecology and environmental protection with psychological support, including group sessions and individual consultations. Throughout the camp, children work on their own mini-projects. They gain basic knowledge of environmental education, learn to understand environmental problems, develop values of responsible attitudes toward nature, and practise ways to solve these problems in real life. This approach combines the development of critical thinking, social engagement, and personal maturity.

### Impact of the camp programme:

Nurturing a sense of care and responsibility for one's community and country;  
Developing environmental awareness and sensitivity to ecological issues;  
Building skills to tackle environmental problems;  
Teamwork and delivering a project from idea to implementation;  
Learning tools for active participation in social change.

## «UA MODE»

Teenagers immerse themselves in the world of fashion and creative industries: they work with trends and references, learn to present themselves and their ideas, and create their own mini-project (a lookbook, visual presentation, or short videos). In parallel, they enjoy active recreation in the mountains, excursions, sports games, and daily psychological support.

The camp programme combines educational, psychological, and wellness components. Within the educational block, teenagers follow modules on fashion in film and culture, Ukrainian traditions and contemporary style, the basics of personal image and a budget-friendly wardrobe, body plasticity and boundaries, and content creation (street-fashion interviews, reels/TikTok), as well as preparing and presenting their own looks under the motto “Wear yours. Love yours.” Psychologists conduct group and individual sessions, teaching techniques of self-regulation, reflection, and safe interaction within a team.

Career exploration in fashion and creative industries  
Portfolio and self-presentation (personal mini-project + pitch)  
Soft skills and emotional resilience (teamwork, communication, self-regulation)

# «EXPEDITION»

The camp is a tent camp in the heart of nature. The programme is packed with sports and adventure activities: river rafting, airsoft, rock climbing, SUP surfing, kayaking, archery, and archery tag. Participants learn the basics of tactical medicine, train teamwork, creativity, and endurance. Every day they join team games, workshops, evening performances, and work on a short film as a final project. A dedicated game zone offers board games and tournaments. The camp atmosphere combines adventure, physical development, and an unforgettable team experience.


## Impact of the camp programme:

Overcoming screen dependence through the joy of face-to-face communication;  
Developing physical strength, endurance, and coordination;  
Building team spirit, strategic thinking, and leadership skills;  
Learning the basics of tactical medicine and gaining confidence in crisis situations;  
Lowering stress levels thanks to nature, movement, and self-discipline;  
Creating an atmosphere of friendship, belonging, and adventure.

# «ГОЇРА!»

Adventure tent camps and hiking trips for children. Kids engage with the world around them, face real-life challenges, and learn independence and self-confidence while developing imagination, creativity, and a love of active living.

A key feature of the camp is small mixed-age groups and an adaptive programme co-created by children and counsellors. Each day, participants hike, scramble over rocks, swim in the river, cook meals, learn outdoor skills, join creative workshops, play board games, and gather around evening campfires. The camp is mobile: groups travel to remote scenic locations, explore the area, and discover local legends. Inclusivity is a core principle: groups are formed so that children with different social backgrounds can integrate, learn empathy, and feel a sense of unity.


## Impact of the camp programme:

- Helping to overcome gadget dependence through the joy of real-life communication
- Fostering emotional maturity, creativity, and a love of nature
- Bringing together children with different social backgrounds and nurturing empathy and respect for others

## «ONE CAMP»

It is a space for children that combines rest, fun, and development. Each camp session can have its own theme — sports, educational, or creative — but is always focused on wellbeing, socialisation, and active leisure. All sessions are accompanied by the Fund's psychologists, who support children both in groups and individually.

The camp offers a varied, full daily programme: excursions, workshops, competitions, and games. A team of experienced counsellors looks after the children, keeping them engaged and creating an atmosphere of safety and trust. The camp is based in a hotel in a picturesque area with a private territory, a winter hill for outdoor activities, a playground, and dance and play rooms.

### Impact of the camp programme:

- Improved wellbeing through active recreation
- Development of communication and teamwork skills
- Support in socialisation through diverse activities and games
- Space for creative self-expression (workshops, competitions)
- Ongoing psychological support that helps children feel safe

This includes financial statements and all contracts with service providers (accommodation and meals, transport, tickets, staff). If requested by the donor, we also provide a budget vs actual report, a narrative report, photos, feedback from families, children's stories, and examples of the programme's impact.

We also add the results of the children's diagnostic questionnaires.
