participating in these projects, students not only learn about the structure, needs, and growth of trees but also develop a deeper understanding of their role in environmental protection. This hands-on involvement fosters a sense of responsibility and empowers students to make informed decisions regarding the conservation and sustainable use of natural resources.

The “**Greening Uganda Schools**” initiative thus serves as a model for how environmental education can be seamlessly integrated into school curricula, providing lasting benefits to students, schools, and the broader community. ## PROJECT OVERVIEW

### Objectives

The primary objectives of the “**Support Greening Uganda Schools 1,000,000 Trees**” project are:

- 1. Reforestation:** Plant one million trees in 260 school compounds and surrounding communities in Uganda.
- 2. Environmental Education:** Educate children about the importance of trees and forests, fostering a love for nature and sustainable management practices.
- 3. Climate Change Mitigation:** Reduce the adverse effects of climate change by increasing tree cover, which will help in carbon sequestration.
- 4. Biodiversity Conservation:** Enhance biodiversity by providing habitats for wildlife through increased tree cover.
- 5. Community Engagement:** Raise awareness among school children and communities about environmental conservation and sustainability.

## CHALLENGES ADDRESSED

Uganda faces significant environmental challenges, including:

- **Deforestation:** Uganda loses approximately 90,000 hectares of forest annually, leading to environmental degradation and loss of biodiversity.
- **Climate Change:** Increased frequency and severity of weather events such as floods and droughts, attributed to climate change.
- **Environmental Education Deficit:** Lack of awareness and education about the importance of environmental conservation among children and communities.

## **SOLUTIONS IMPLEMENTED**

To address these challenges, PLANE implemented the following solutions:

- **Tree Planting Activities:** Engaged students and communities in planting one million trees. We have so planted 4850 trees in 26 primary and secondary schools.
- **Educational Programs:** Conducted workshops and seminars in schools to educate children about the benefits of trees and forests. We have printed out some posters with good climate change action messages for the children to learn the importance of tree planting and respecting nature.
- **Community Involvement:** Encouraged community participation in tree planting and maintenance activities. We've used the radio talkshows on Voice of Toro 101 FM to educate the public about tree planting and climate change issues.
- **Partnerships and Fundraising:** Collaborated with local and international partners to raise funds and resources for the project. We've been allowed to host our campaigns on GlobalGiving platform. This

global platform has enabled us to gain visibility and attract donors. PLANE received a donor who donated to us \$2000 for the Greening Uganda Project implementation. This money has facilitated PLANE to reach out 15 schools .
