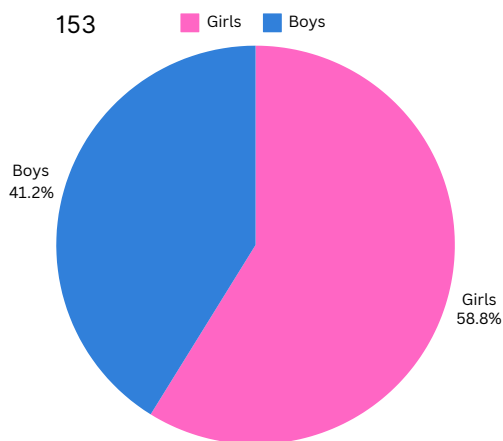

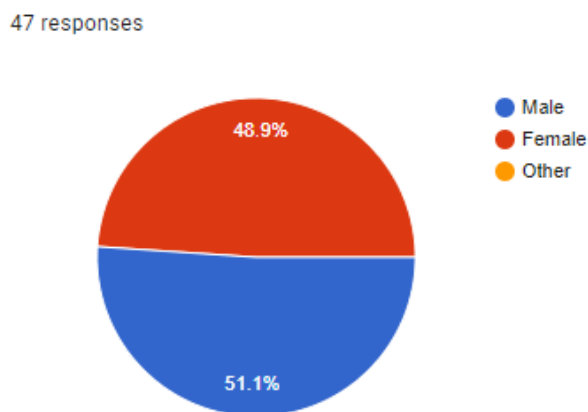
A4C BY THE NUMBERS

- 3 Fundraising avenues established

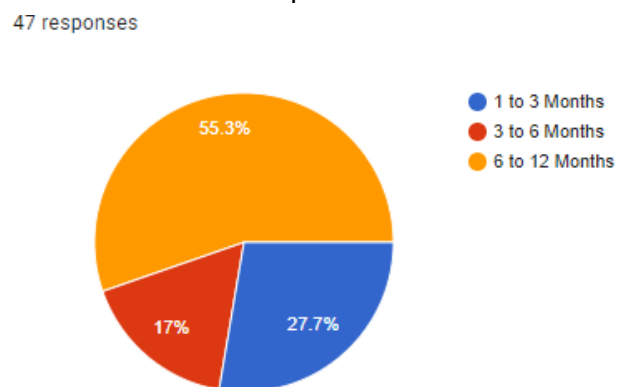
Children reached by gender



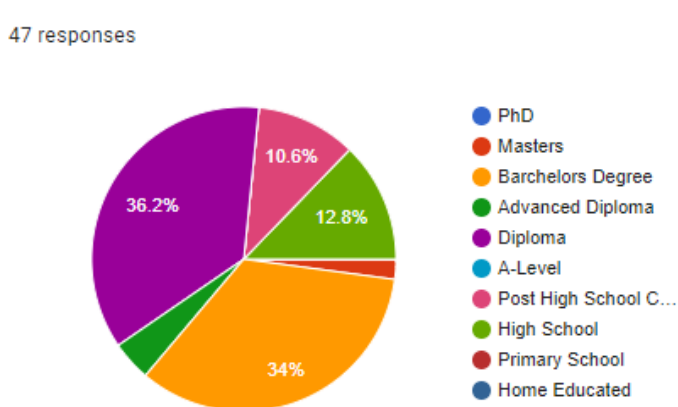
No. of volunteers by gender



Preferred volunteer periods



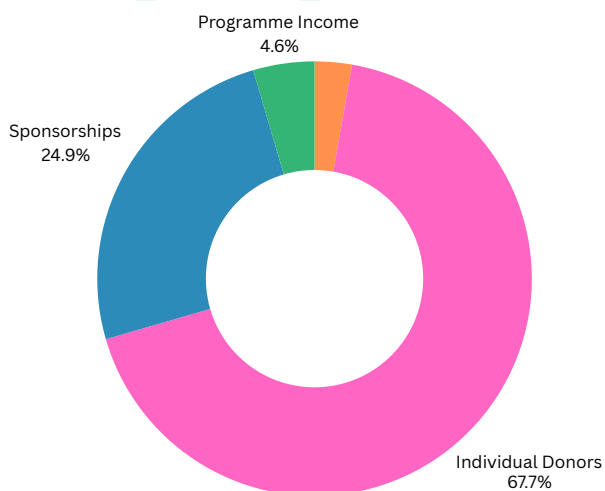
Volunteers' level of education



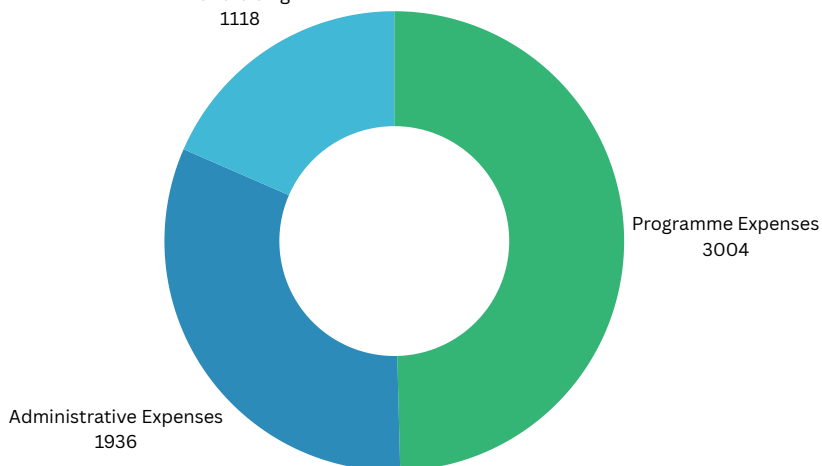
