3,750 children die because of diarrhea related to lack of access to safe water.



Egypt is heading towards absolute water scarcity (500 m³ per capita)



Annual Water deficit is 7 billion m³ and country could run out of water by 2025



7.3 million people are deprived of access to safe water.



Population explosion expected to be 110 millions by 2025, which threatens water resources.
